Christy Wisuthseriwong has been Director of Music at Presbyterian Church of the Cross since January 2008, wearing every musical hat available. In addition to working with the minister in selecting music for services, she is the pianist, organist, and director of our three choirs – Adult, Voices of Angels (children and youth), and Bells of Praise (handbell). She was implemental in organizing our Children and Youth Choir, and Handbell Choir, and makes possible many of the concerts and guest artists at PCC.

Christy is the Dean of Faculty and an Associate Master Teacher at The Music Academy of North Carolina in Greensboro. She received her Bachelor's of Music in piano performance and pedagogy at Meredith College in Raleigh and studied Collaborative Piano at the University of North Carolina at Greensboro, where she earned her Master's of Music in 2001 and Doctor of Musical Arts in 2011. Dr. Wisuthseriwong has taught piano at The Music Academy of NC since 2006 and is active in the musical life of the Triad area. From 2009-2012, she was an adjunct faculty member in the music department at Guilford College in Greensboro. Christy has been an accompanist for the American Singers' Opera Project at Wake Forest University in Winston-Salem, the Greensboro Opera Company chorus, NC-NATS auditions, and Community Theatre of Greensboro. She has worked frequently as an accompanist for the UNCG Opera Theatre Department, playing for the Opera Tour to the Schools and the North Carolina premiere of Mark Adamo's *Little Women*, among other shows. She has performed chamber music recitals as a guest artist at various schools around the country, including Elon University, Furman University, Duquesne University, and Ball State University. In the summer of 2006, Christy participated in the Summer Piano Pedagogy Institute at the Longy School of Music in Cambridge, MA. Internationally, Christy attended the opera performance and language study program *Oberlin in Italy* in 2001 and the University of Miami Frost School of Music German lieder program for singers and pianists in Salzburg, Austria in 2007.

Christy enjoys traveling the world and exploring other cultures. In her spare time, she enjoys running, doing yoga, cooking (and eating!), and spending time with her husband Edgar.
