Our speaker Jenna Schroeder, Executive Director of NAMI Brown County. The National Alliance on Mental Illness is a cost-free program which has 650 chapters throughout the country. Jenna is the only NAMI paid person in Green Bay with all the other people involved being volunteers. One of their biggest concerns is Suicide prevention. Throughout the country the largest group of those committing Suicide are men 55 and over. In our area the largest group committing Suicide are 20–27-year-olds. Jenna told us that it is estimated that 1 in 5 people have some type of Mental Illness.
