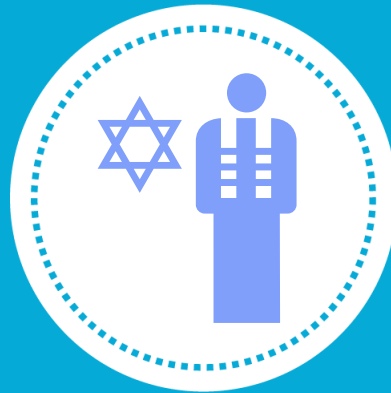


# Abraham's Seed: Israel

After the cosmic rebellion, man was under the control of the angelic beings over the nations. God intervenes by choosing Abraham to bring salvation through his descendants (Deuteronomy 7:7-8). While the other nations worshipped idols, Israel was required to worship only Yahweh (Deuteronomy 4:15-20). God wanted Israel to be a holy nation and a kingdom of priests (Exodus 19:5-6). It is from Israel, through the line of Judah that Jesus Christ came into the world, to save men from their sins.

God calls Abram from Ur of the Chaldeans to go to a country that he would cause him to see. Genesis 11: 27-32

God promised Abraham that he would make him a great nation. Genesis 12: 1-3

God promised Abraham that his descendants would be as the stars of heaven. Genesis 15:5-21



God's promise to Abraham passes on to Isaac. Genesis 22: 15-18

God makes the promise to Isaac. Genesis 26:1-5.

Isaac has two sons, but Jacob is the son of promise. Genesis 25:19-34



God's promise passes on to Jacob. Genesis 28:27-29.

Jacob has 12 sons, who would become the twelve tribes of Israel. Genesis 30:1-24.

God gives Jacob a new name: Israel. Genesis 32:24-28. Genesis 35:9-12.
