

## GOODTIME MIXED LEAGUE RULES 2021/2022

1. The Goodtime league will consist of up to 12 teams. Each team will have 3 players, 1 man, 1 woman, or a 2 to 1 mix. Teams may have a 4 or 5 member team, but this must be declared on the first night of bowling. Bowlers who bowl on a 4 or 5 man team may not substitute for another team in the league. **With only 8 bowlers it will guys against the girls each week in hope that the league will rebuild in the future.**
2. Bowling will begin on Sept. 9<sup>th</sup> and end April 7<sup>th</sup>. Practice at approximately 8:30 and begin as soon as the men are done on Lanes 3-4 and bowl for 28 weeks. We will not bowl on Nov. 25, Thanksgiving, and Dec. 23 and 30<sup>th</sup> for Christmas and New Year. **Rolloff will be rotating scotch doubles on Thursday, April 14** and the banquet will be held April 21, 2022. Fun Nights are Dec. 16 Naughty or Nice and Feb. 10 Funky bowl.
3. Weekly bowling fees shall be \$13 per bowler. From these fees, \$9.50 will be paid to the Dome Lanes and \$2.00 will go into the league account. One dollar will go into the New Prize Fund and \$.50 into the Magic Score. Teams must pay in full each week ... NO PAY, NO PLAY. Each team may decide how they wish their subs to pay.
4. This is a non-sanctioned league.
5. The sponsor fee is waived for 2021-2022. Normally \$30 per team and is to be paid by the third week.
6. Three games will be bowled each session using the 7 point system: 2 points for games won and 1 point for total pins. Handicap will be 100% of the difference between average and scratch, no limit. Scratch will be 180 for everyone, men and women. Individual stats will be kept for the year.
7. Should the league have an odd number of teams, the odd team will play against another teams scores for their wins and loses that week.
8. We shall bowl 4 7-week sessions for prize money purposes only. All teams will roll off on April 14. Winners to be determined by total pins. Round Robin format with four games played.
9. A substitute may be used in the rolloff, but the bowler's average may not be over 10 pins of the absent bowler. There will be no new subs in the last three weeks of each half.
10. In the case of a team dropping out of the league and a new team replacing it, the new

team will be eligible for awards as long as they bowl 2/3 of the half. Any individual bowler quitting is asked to give at least two week's notice. Two Thirds of the half is required for prizes for individuals.

11. Members who arrive late to bowl have until the 5th frame is completed by both teams to be able to enter into the game. Beyond the 5th frame, the late bowler's score will be that of the absentee score for that bowler.

12. An absentee score will be used if the regular bowler cannot find a substitute. The absentee score will be the bowler's average minus 20 pins plus their handicap (175). If an absent bowler has not yet established an average, a score of 120 with handicap (195) will be used.

13. The vacancy score, a score of 180, will be used when a team does not have a full team roster.

14. If there is an equipment failure, bowling on one lane will be allowed.

15. On Nov. 18 and Dec. 16, we will bowl for turkeys and hens and hams and spams respectively. Prizes will be awarded to high series with handicap, one for men and one for women. Prize limits to one per person per year. In case of a tie, a name will be drawn. Cost of turkeys and hams is approximately \$90.

16. On Oct. 28, we will bowl for candy bars. Each bowler is to bring 6 **full** size candy bars (24 per team). The bars will be placed in a box and each time you get a strike you may select a bar continuing until all bars are gone. Once the bars are gone, you may "steal" from someone who has more than six. You do not have to participate if you do not wish to, but if you have not brought candy, do not take any.

17. On Dec. 16, we will have a Christmas Potluck. Details will be given as the date approaches. There will also be a gift exchange (maximum \$15 cost). Each bowler brings a gift and when you bowl your first strike you select a gift. Once again ... you do not have to participate, but if you do not bring a gift, do not take one.

18. On Feb. 10, we will have a Valentine's Day Pot Luck. Details will be given as the date approaches. Sign Up sheet will be passed out for all the sweethearts in the league.

19. The lanes will be oiled before league starts bowling each week.

20. The banquet will be held April 21, 2022. Dome Lanes will hold a cocktail hour with

a time to be announced. Menu will be steaks and baked potatoes catered by the Dome Lanes. Teams may bring desserts.

21. The secretary's fee is \$20. The Treasurer's fee is \$75.

22. Music will be allowed on the lanes during league play at a volume that is enjoyable by all.
