_____ **National Rodeo Membership Application** completed and printed from the online portal. Instructions on website. Both parents/guardians **MUST** sign the bottom of this form along with the contestant and upload to the online membership portal. Attach this document to the online membership portal using the drop-down menu item specified. If only one parent signs, you **MUST** declare reason.

_____ **National Minor's Release, Assumption of Risk and Indemnity Agreement** completed and printed from the online program. The natural Father and Mother or the Legal Guardian along with the contestant **MUST** sign this form. **This form MUST be Notarized (be sure notary lists contestant and both parents as being present when notarized).** Attach this document to the online membership portal using the drop-down menu item specified.

*** _____ **COVID Release Form** - **This form MUST be Notarized (be sure notary lists contestant and both parents as being present when notarized).** Attach this document along with other STATE documents with *** as one PDF and upload to the online membership portal.

*** _____ **Current Grade Transcripts** - Fall rodeos it must be the end of the previous year report card; Spring rodeos it must be 2nd quarter report card or 1st semester report card.

*** _____ **Parent Membership & Photo Release Form** - print, sign and upload with the other state (***) forms. \$25 ONE - Parent Membership Fee **OR** \$35 TWO - Parent Membership Fee. (At least ONE parent **MUST** pay membership and that gives voting rights.) This fee may be submitted via PayPal, Venmo or brought to the first rodeo! Must be paid prior to start of rodeo!

*** _____ **KYHSRA Medical Release Form** - print, BOTH parents must sign, upload to membership portal.

*** _____ **Homeschool Verification Form** - If your contestant is enrolled in a homeschool program, you must print, sign and upload with the other state (***) forms.

_____ **\$35 State Membership Fee** - may be submitted via PayPal, Venmo or brought to the first rodeo! Must be paid prior to start of rodeo!

WELCOME

Welcome to the 2021-2022 Kentucky High School Rodeo Season!! We are preparing for a new season, and it promises to be a great one. Please feel free to contact me via email - kyhsra@outlook.com – or by text, 270-703-4721, if questions arise.

Below are a few details that should help.

- Membership applications AND rodeo entries for the 2021-2022 season will be all online. You will go to our website homepage and follow the link for entering each rodeo online. Entries will be announced on the website and the KYHSRA Facebook page as to when they open.
- Although it is not required, we encourage you to pay fees prior to each event via Paypal or Venmo. Sending a check via snail mail is not recommended. If cash or check is your only option, you will do that at check-in. We do not accept credit cards.
- At your first rodeo of the season, you will receive a membership packet that will include your rulebook, back number and any important paperwork.
- Back numbers must be worn on contestant's **back** at all times during the weekend. This means everywhere you go.
- You must be in **western attire** at the start of the rodeo and remain that way until the rodeo for the day is completely over (not just when your event has ended).
- Our official magazine is the Rodeo News. You will receive a subscription as a part of your membership.
- We also have a website; it is located at www.kyhsr.com and a Facebook page - **Kentucky High School Rodeo Association**. **All information will be shared through these sources.** Stay informed!
- We will have Cowboy Church services on Sunday morning at each rodeo event.
- Each contestant will be responsible for turning in \$300 in sponsorship for the year. This can be paid all at one time or broken up. \$150 must be paid by our October rodeo weekend and the other \$150 must be paid by our March rodeo weekend. This money can come from family, friends and/or businesses. You will need to turn in a sponsorship form with any money.
