



The LWV of Evanston Scholarship Program

Each year the League of Women Voters of Evanston awards a scholarship to one Evanston Township High School student in the amount of \$1,500

This award is given to a student that has demonstrated commitment to an activity that promotes participation in the political process within ETHS and/or the Evanston community and exemplifies a high standard of good citizenship and social involvement, consistent with the League's mission. This includes volunteering/participating in activities such as, but not limited to: student government, assisting with voter registration, participating in other organizations that show engagement and interest in public service and the political process.

The applicant shall submit:

- 1) a statement of up to 600 words describing the activities of the applicant which fit into the above criteria for civic engagement;
- 2) a commitment to enroll in an accredited institution of higher learning upon graduation from ETHS;
- 3) a written recommendation prepared by an ETHS faculty member; and
- 4) participate in an interview, if selected.

The scholarship will be paid directly to the recipient.

The League of Women Voters is a nonpartisan political organization that encourages the informed and active participation of citizens in government.
