## Building Permits

With the building and renovation season starting up, the Town of Preeceville would like to remind everyone that development and building permits are required for most new construction projects which include renovations to existing buildings **and** for changes of buildings or land use. This includes sheds, tarp sheds, decks, and fences. These permits ensure your project complies with the Municipal Zoning Bylaw and the National Building Code.
