Beatrice E. Paul, 94, of Pigeon passed away on Thursday, Nov. 23, 2000, at the Scheurer Hospital Long-Term Care Unit in Pigeon following a long illness. She was born in Pigeon on March 18, 1906, the daughter of the late Jacob and Lydia (Faist) Haist. On Aug. 18, 1934, she was united in marriage to John E. "Jack" Paul in Pigeon.
