ORDINANCE NO. 1989-3

An Ordinance to Vacate a Public Way
And to Fix a Time When the Vacation
Will Take Effect

It is ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Cloverdale, Indiana:

1. That the public way commonly known as North Street Extension, Cloverdale, Indiana, and more particularly described as follows --

That part of North Street platted in the Clarke Place Addition to the Town of Cloverdale in Putnam County, Indiana, beginning at the Southeast Corner of Lot 38 in Block 6 of said Clarke Place; thence South 50.0 feet with the East Line of said Clarke Place to the Northeast Corner of Lot 24 in Block 3 of said Addition; thence West 172.00 feet with the North Line of said Lot 24 to the Northwest Corner thereof; thence North 50.0 feet to a point 7 feet west of the Southwest Corner of Lot 33, Block 6; thence East 172.00 feet to the point of beginning, containing 0.197 of an acre,

is hereby vacated and conveyed to the owners of the Clarke Place Addition Lots that abut such public way to the north (one-half) and to the south (one-half).

2. And, that this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after this date.


