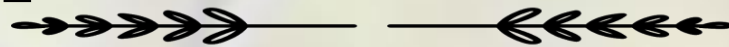


# Alaskan Blueberry Cast-Iron Upside-Down Cake



## Quick & Easy Recipe

This recipe uses only the freshest Alaskan Blueberries, but with an easy twist that anyone can take part in baking it themselves!

1. Preheat oven to 350°
2. Prepare your preferred cake mix as your recipe follows
3. Cut your  $\frac{3}{4}$  stick of butter into cubes
4. Spread your 1  $\frac{1}{2}$  cups brown sugar into bottom of medium cast-iron skillet pan and add your butter cubes
5. Pour your prepared cake mix over the top of the brown sugar and butter cubes
6. Bake at 350° for about 30 minutes or until middle is done. \*Try using a butter knife or toothpick in the center of the cake to test if done.

## Ingredients

1 Box Betty Crocker Yellow Cake Mix (or your preferred Homemade Cake Mix Recipe)

### If using Betty Crocker Mix:

1 Cup Water  
1/3 Cup Softened Butter  
3 Eggs

3 Cups Blueberries  
1  $\frac{1}{2}$  Cups Brown Sugar  
 $\frac{3}{4}$  Stick Butter, cut into cubes
