

Flamingo Gardens Annual Photo Contest 2021

Due February 21, 2021

CALLING ALL PHOTOGRAPHERS

Flamingo Gardens is looking for your best photographs of Flamingo Garden's Botanical Gardens and Everglades Wildlife Sanctuary for exhibition and publication. We are looking for outstanding photographs of the Botanical Gardens and of wildlife in the Everglades Wildlife Sanctuary to be featured in an exhibit in the Gallery from March 20 through May 9, 2021. Selected photographs will be featured on our website and may be featured in a publication for sale in the gift shop. There is no fee to enter, and artists may submit up to 3 entries for consideration.

JURIED EXHIBIT/AWARDS

This is a juried exhibit and the decision of the curator is final. Only those works selected by the curator will be included in the exhibitions and publications. A Best in Show winner will be chosen and receive \$150. First, Second, and Third Place Awards will be selected in each category along with additional Judges Recognition Awards. First place \$100, Second \$75, and Third \$50. All selected finalists in the exhibit will be invited to attend an opening night reception (pending lifting of Covid restrictions) on March 19, 2021, and will be given two complimentary passes to Flamingo Gardens.

CATEGORIES:

All photos must be taken at Flamingo Gardens

I. GARDENS- Images must be of flora and/or landscapes, and non-animal scenes in Flamingo Gardens Botanical Gardens and surrounding grounds.

II. WILDLIFE - Images must be of birds, animals, bugs, reptiles, people with animals, people, and/or animals on exhibit in Flamingo Gardens Everglades Wildlife Sanctuary.

ELIGIBILITY/MEDIA

The photo contest is open to all artists. **Only photographs taken at Flamingo Gardens will be considered for this competition.** Images may be computer enhanced.

ENTRY/FEES

There is no fee to enter. Artists may submit up to 3 images for consideration (Maximum 3 images). Images should be submitted in JPEG

format and should be at least 300 dpi in resolution with a minimum dimension of 1800 pixels in the shortest dimension. Applications and images are **due by February 21, 2021, 5pm** and may be emailed to events@flamingogardens.org along with the artists' application. Images may also be submitted by mail, on a disc or flash drive, to: Cori Glick, Director of Events, Flamingo Gardens, 3750 S. Flamingo Road, Davie, FL 33330.

Intake & Acceptance:

All accepted finalists' photographs must be no smaller than 8"x10" (not including frame) and no larger than 4' in either direction (including frame) for exhibit. All photographs must be framed behind glass or plexiglass or professionally mounted on hardboard. **All mounting and framing must be wired and ready to hang or display. No sawtooth hangers, notch hangers or clips will be accepted, no exceptions!**

Poor framing may disqualify selected photographs from being exhibited. Artwork should be **clearly tagged on the back with the artist's name, the title of the piece and sales price or NFS.**

Accepted photographs for the exhibit are to be delivered to Flamingo Gardens by **March 14, 2021, 5pm**, unless prior arrangements have been made.

PLEASE DO NOT BRING FRAMED WORK TO GARDENS UNTIL YOU HAVE BEEN NOTIFIED THAT YOUR WORK HAS BEEN CHOSEN AS A FINALIST FOR THE EXHIBIT.
