Gilbert L. "Gil" Guillett, 61, of Oconto, Wisconsin, died Friday, December 8, 2006, at St. Vincent Hospital in Green Bay after a major stroke. He was born September 23, 1945 in Gagetown, son of Herb and Elsie (Maholic) Guillett. He graduated from Owendale High School in 1963. He enlisted in the United States Navy and served during the Vietnam War. In 1966, he was united in marriage to Rebecca Preston of White Creek, West Virginia.
