Registration Day

- July 2nd at the Beach 10:00am-1:00pm
- Swimmers/parents to not attend if they or their children are feeling ill please call to register instead.
- Swimmers/parents to follow guidelines, social distancing during registration

Lessons

- Start July 3rd
- Beached to be closed to the public during lessons (only registered students, instructors, parents and siblings allowed in during lessons)
- 2 lessons to run concurrently, social distancing will be practiced between the 2 lessons
- Swimmers are encouraged to bring own life jackets
- Swim staff will disinfect all swim equipment in between each lesson
- Swimmers are encouraged to arrive on time for lessons and encouraged to arrive as close to the time as possible not to be waiting on beach all day for lesson to start
- Swimmers/parents are not to attend if they are experiencing any signs/symptoms of Covid-19, have travelled outside of the country in the last 14 days, are feeling sick or have a fever.
- Social distancing strongly encouraged on the beach following provincial guidelines
- Reminder children/parents use hand sanitizer before/after using play structure and wash-rooms at beach

2020 MUNICIPAL ELECTION

Please note that due to the current COVID-19 global pandemic, the date for the **Municipal Election has changed to August 29, 2020** rather than July 25, 2020. **The Advanced poll date and time TBD.**

The 2020 Election will be held at the Village Shop located at the boat launch. The voting hours are from 8:00 am to 9:00 pm. Please note the following plans for keeping the voting safe from COVID-19 for both election officials and voters:

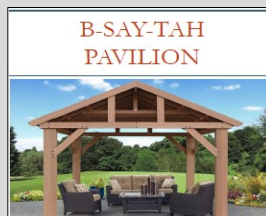
- **Call for Nominations July 10, 2020**
- **Nomination Day July 25, 2020 until 2:00pm**
- Election officials encouraged to wear masks and disposable gloves.
- Sanitizing protocols will be used on tables, desks, door handles, voting pencils, the washroom, etc.
- While you wait your turn to register and pick up your ballot, you will be asked to maintain a 6 ft. distance from other voters. The waiting area will be just outside the entry door.
- After Voters mark their ballot, they will be encouraged to insert their own folded ballot into the ballot box.
- All voters are encouraged to wear masks (whether they are home-made cloth masks or commercial masks).
- The same safety procedures will apply for the advanced poll
