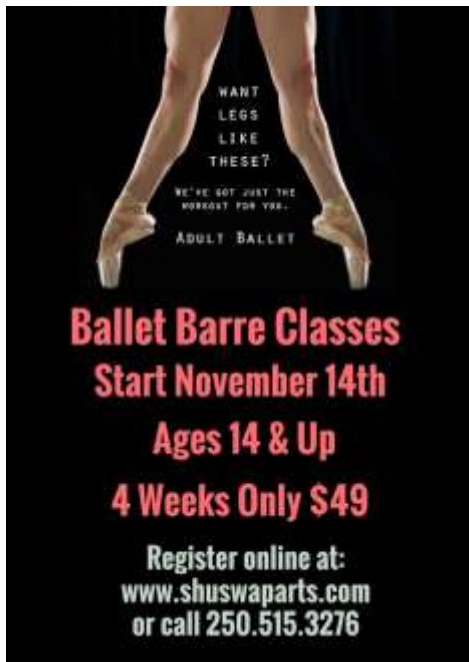


NEW ART SESSION STARTING NOVEMBER 2ND

ADULT BALLET BARRE STARTS MONDAY NOVEMBER 14TH

Adult Ballet Barre starts Monday November 14th at the FACES studios (lower level of Carlin Hall). Class time will run 7:00 to 7:55 pm. This will be a short four week session to 'test the waters' on whether there is interest in this area for this rapidly growing dance form.

Most barre based classes use a combination of postures inspired by ballet and other disciplines like yoga and pilates. The barre is used as a prop to balance while doing exercises that focus on isometric strength training combined with reps of small range of motion movements.
