I have checked my files regarding the Heath Stocks Homicide Investigation, and I have not been able to locate the Crime Scene Video that was completed on the evening of 01-17-99.

Since speaking with you last, I have checked my files, as well as the files at the ASP-CID Lonoke County Field Office, and have not located the tape. I spoke with Investigator Steve Finch, Lonoke County Sheriff's Office, on May 31, 1999, and asked if he had a copy of the tape. Finch told me that he didn't believe that he had a copy of the tape, but that he would check. All other physical evidence is stored at the Lonoke County Sheriff's Office.

On May 28, 1999, I spoke with Mac Carder of the Arkansas Public Defenders Commission about the tape. Carder represented Heath Stocks prior to sentencing. Carder told me that he did not have a copy of the tape, but that he did remember viewing the tape while he represented Stocks.

I spoke with former Prosecuting Attorney Larry Cook about the tape several months ago, when I was transferring my Lonoke County files to my office in Mountain Home. Cook told me that he did not have the tape and that he would transfer his files on Heath Stocks to the newly elected Prosecutor when she takes office.

I know that a tape exist because I was the Investigator that filmed the scene, and Attorneys on both sides of the case have viewed the tape. The case file was maintained at the Lonoke County Field Office for several months with no

one working out of the office. The access to the office was probably not controlled, but I doubt that the tape was taken. I believe that it has been misplaced between the parties that have viewed it since the January 1997 murders.

There is documentation in my case file that I transferred photographs and audio tapes to the Prosecutor's Office, but there is not an ASP-2 that list any video tape.

As of this time, I am unable to locate the crime scene video regarding the Stock's Homicide Investigation.
