Aloha Kakou,

Every now and then when I am pondering what to write for the newsletter, I grab my "church notebook" in which I jot down thoughts and ideas about spiritual and organizational life here at CLC and flip through it. That happened for a bit this morning.

My current notebook begins around November 18th of last year. With notes on a pledge drive letter. It then continues with a welter of notes on what seems to be happening in the world, the ELCA, the country, the islands and most of all, Christ Lutheran Church. And what we might try next.

I had an organizational mentor who loved to ask, "What do we do next when we don't know what's happening next?" People would just stare at him as he grinned and chuckled at them. He loved tossing uncertainty into people's plans for their future. He was a big fan of complexity, too.

I have got to admit that it is a good question — what do we do when we don't know what's happening next? What can a leader do? How can a pastor or lay church officer lead in such uncertain times? If leaders cannot plan, predict, and control, what is it that leaders can do, should do?

I think my favorite definition of a leader, whether secular or sacred, is someone who can stand with others and offer them the courage to take next steps into a fast-changing, increasingly complicated, and radically uncertain future, a future full of instability, unpredictability, and unmanageability. I think that should be doubly true for pastors of congregations.

Dr Robert Wicks, one of our two speakers at The Oasis last week, talked about pastors being present with others, with self, and with God. That is the core of what pastors do, he said. "Helping people through the night," he added.

That jives well with the very serious joke that often surfaces at strategic planning retreats – what does God do when God espies people making plans? God laughs.

As we head into the year's final two months of busy-ness, from Halloween and Thanksgiving to Christmas and New Year's, a lot is going to come at us. Let's remember that God is with us, giving us the courage and the faith to take next steps. And to take them together.

Because they are an all-volunteer organization with minimal operating expenses, all monies and goods donated go directly to those people who can use them the most.
