



HEART and More HEART

Hillsborough Homeless Engagement and Retention in Tenancy (HEART) and More Heart programs are two separate programs under one roof. Both programs provide permanent supportive housing to chronically homeless persons with a disability. The programs are based on the Housing First and Role Recovery models.

All participants are identified through street outreach, and through Coordinated Entry System through our local Continuum of Care through Tampa Hillsborough Homeless Initiative (THHI). All households must have an income equal to or less than 50% of the median area, and at least one adult member of the household must have a disability which impairs their functioning level including, one or more of the following diagnosable disorders: substance use disorder, serious mental health, developmental disability, or chronic physical illness limiting their ability to work or perform one or more activities of daily living.

The participants find housing within Hillsborough County at scattered sites. Services available to participants include: housing, employment assistance, transportation assistance, primary care/health care and entitlement enrollment, linkage to other community support services to address their individual needs.

All participants must comply with case management services to be in the program.
