 And may all your Christmas's be white.

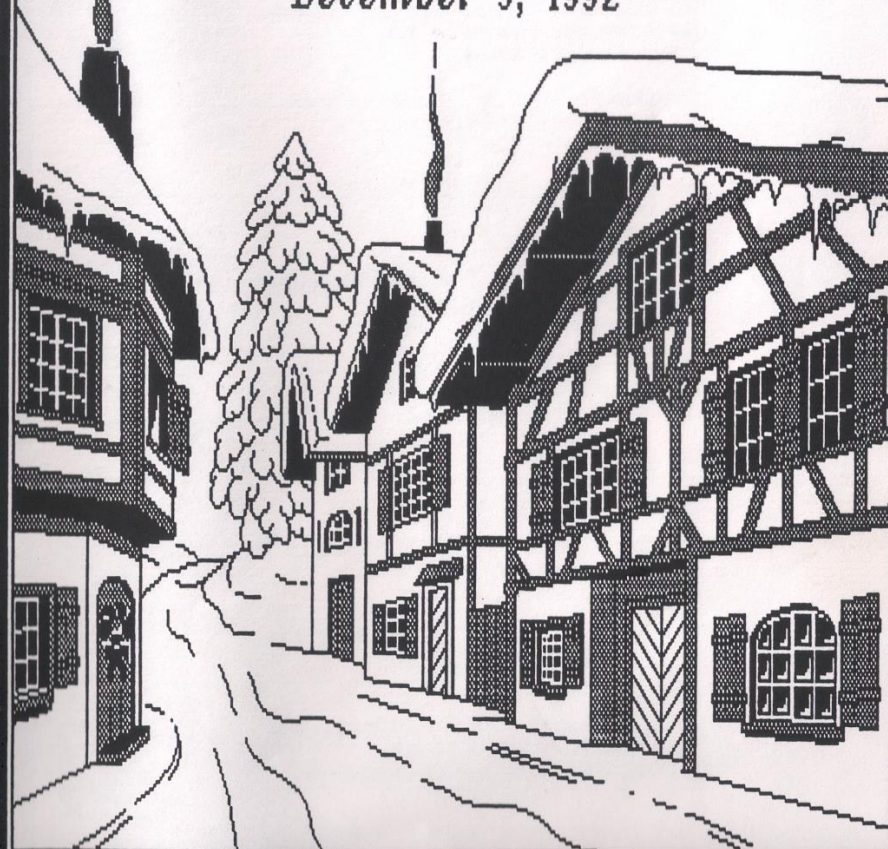
JINGLE BELLS
