First-ever auction of City properties scheduled for January 25

Press conference to be held today at 11 a.m. at City Hall

The City will conduct its first-ever auction of 56 residential and commercial properties it owns on January 25, 2014, and will use sales proceeds to help fund capital improvements.

The auction will be held at 11 a.m. on Saturday, January 25 at Newcomb Hall, located at the Municipal Marina, 180 E. 13th Street. Pompano Beach-based Fisher Auction Co. is managing the marketing and auction process.

To register and for instructions on how to participate in the auction, potential buyers should visit www.fisherauction.com. Bidding will also be available online and by telephone. All bidders must be pre-qualified.

A press conference to explain the process will be held at 11 a.m. today in the City Council Chambers at City Hall, 600 W. Blue Heron Boulevard, second floor. Lamar Fisher, president and CEO of Fisher Auction, will be joined by Riviera Beach Mayor Thomas A. Masters and other officials.

The City acquired the properties through the tax escheatment process and for use in its now-defunct infill housing program. The properties available for auction include single-family homes and lots, multi-family and commercial development sites.

Fisher Auction Co. has extensive experience handling municipal auctions throughout south Florida, including the auction of the Miami Arena. It also has handled numerous high-profile auctions including the former Versace mansion on South Beach and numerous private islands and multi-million-dollar mansions.
