Mary P. Cominsky, 76, of Sand Point, formerly of East Detroit, passed away Wednesday, April 10, 2002, at Bay Regional Medical Center in Bay City. She was born on June 20, 1925, in Detroit, daughter of the late Anthony and Rose (Scalzo) DeSilva. On June 26, 1948, she was united in marriage to Harold A.
