



### St. Francis of Assisi

Born: 1181 or 1182 Assisi, Holy Roman Empire

"Lord, make me an instrument of thy peace. Where there is hatred, let me sow love, Where there is injury, pardon; Where there is doubt, faith; Where there is despair, hope; Where there is darkness, light; And where there is sadness, joy.

O Divine Master, grant that I may not so much seek to be consoled as to console, to be understood as to understand, to be loved, as to love. For it is in giving that we receive, It is in pardoning that we are pardoned, and it is in dying that we are born to eternal life."

Francis of Assisi was a preacher, deacon, Catholic friar, founder of four religious institutions and one of the most venerated religious figures in history. He considered himself "no friend of Christ if he did not cherish those for whom Christ died" which included nature which he believed was the mirror of God and would often preach to the birds since he called all creatures his brothers and sisters.



Stand fast therefore in the liberty wherewith Christ hath made us free, and be not entangled again with the yoke of bondage.


**Question:** There are so many things in life that we can become entangled in that leaves us in bondage. What are some of the things you need to be set free from?
