# VILLAGE OF COHOCTON MONTHLY MEETING February 20, 2019

The monthly meeting of the Cohocton Village Board of Trustees was held on Wednesday, February 20, 2019 at 7:00 pm, in the Village Office, 17 South Main Street, Cohocton.

#### **Minutes**

A motion was made by Trustee Freelove, seconded by Trustee Martin, to approve the January 16, 2019 Board meeting minutes as presented. The motion carried 5-0.

## Reports

The Board reviewed the Code Enforcement report.

The Board reviewed the Fire Department report.

Maintenance Supervisor Justin Coats gave the Board an oral Street and Water report.

No Assessor's report was received.

The Board reviewed the Joint Town and Village Planning Board minutes and discussed the new comprehensive plan.

A motion was made by Trustee Freelove, seconded by Trustee Azzi to approve the monthly reports as presented. The motion carried 5-0.

A motion was made by Trustee Freelove, seconded by Trustee Azzi to approve the three new fire department applications. Moving forward there will be a zero tolerance policy regarding the behavior of members of the fire department. All members must be respectful to Fire Department Officers, Village employees and residents and act in a respectful manner or they will be terminated. The motion carried 5-0.

A motion was made by Trustee Freelove, seconded by Trustee Azzi to hold a public hearing on the new comprehensive plan March 20, 2019 at 7:00 pm. The motion carried 5-0.

A motion was made by Trustee Azzi, seconded by Trustee Freelove to grant the request made by Station 26 for a 30 day waiver. The motion carried 5-0.

A motion was made by Trustee Freelove, seconded by Trustee Martin to remove the wall in the Village Office that used to be the old Town Clerk window to make the room more conducive as a meeting room and to mail a letter to the Town Supervisor requesting permission. The motion carried 5-0.

A motion was made by Trustee Freelove, seconded by Trustee Martin to hold budget work sessions on the following days:

February 26<sup>th</sup> at 6:00 pm, March 5<sup>th</sup> at 6:00 pm, and March 6<sup>th</sup> at 6:00 pm.

The motion carried 5-0.

A motion was made by Trustee Martin, seconded by Trustee Kastberg to hold a public hearing for local law #1 of 2019 "A local law overriding the property tax cap" on March 20, 2019 at 7:00 pm. The motion carried 5-0.

A motion was made by Trustee Freelove, seconded by Trustee Kastberg to allow Margie Adams use of the Village streets for the annual Wheels for life bike-a-thon on May 11, 2019. The motion carried 5-0.

A motion was made by Trustee Azzi, seconded by Trustee Freelove to all Village Employees to attend the annual Southern Tier Leadership conference. The motion carried 5-0.
