

Town of Rockford Public Hearing October 12, 2016 7:00pm

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Mayor Carrie Roecks called the meeting to order at 7:00pm.

Roll call took place. Those present were Mayor Carrie Roecks, Councilmembers Clint Stevenson, Micki Harnois, new councilmember Tim Fricke, who was sworn into office October 7th, 2016, and Jim Oshanick. William Benson was absent.

Ms. Roecks stated that the purpose of the meeting was to discuss projects that the town could apply for to be funded by the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) for 2017.

There were suggestions about paving some of the problematic roads around town, upgrading part of the water and sewer systems, and focusing on fixing some of Infiltration and Inflow (I&I).

Layne Merritt, with JUB Engineers, reminded council that CDBG does not have planning funds, but they fund actual projects. Water and sewer projects are typically what they emphasize their funding on.

Mr. Merritt said that he would look at some numbers and let council know how much I&I could be repaired with the next round of funding.

It was discussed that this year the CDBG funding needs to be for a single project with a single funding agency.

Mr. Stevenson made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Mr. Oshanick seconded the motion. Motion was carried.

The public hearing was adjourned at 7:55pm
