

NEED HELP WITH YOUR UTILITY BILLS? PAYMENT PLANS ARE AVAILABLE



TELEPHONE LIFELINE







If you're experiencing difficulties paying your utility bills, you are not alone. Do you need more time to pay the full bill or need an extended payment arrangement? If so, contact your utility company to ask for an individualized payment plan.

If you can't arrange a personalized plan, electric and natural gas utilities regulated by the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio are required to offer you one of the following payment plans:

"One-Ninth" Plan - allows you to pay your past-due amount in nine equal monthly payments. In addition, you will be set up on a budget plan.

"One-Sixth" Plan - allows you to pay pastdue amount in six equal monthly payments. You must also pay your current usage amount each month.

Percentage of Income Payment Plan (PIPP PLUS) - allows you to pay a percentage of your household's monthly income instead of the full bill amount. Households with total income at or below 175% of the federal income guidelines may be eligible.

Budget Billing - allows you to pay a set amount for your utilites each month based on your average use over 12 months.

If you are behind on your utility bill payments contact your utilities immediately to make payment arrangements.

Lifeline is a Federal Communications Commission (FCC) program that provides a monthly benefit for income-eligible households to help ensure that they can afford communications services, either through a participating wireline, wireless, or broadband provider.

Lifeline services are offered by participating local telephone carriers to consumers with a household income at or below 135% of the federal income guidelines, or who provide proof of participation in at least one of the following programs:


Home Energy Assistance Summer Crisis Program



From July 1 through Sept. 30, income-eligible Ohioans can receive assistance in paying their electric bill, purchasing an air conditioner or fan, or making repairs to their central air conditioning unit through the Ohio Department of Development's Home Energy Assistance Summer Crisis Program (HEAP).

Registration takes less than seven minutes and can be completed in these easy steps:


- · Visit energyhelp.ohio.gov, and click "Log into the EA portal."
- Click "Create an OHID," and follow the six-step account creation process.
 - Ensure account security by setting up multi-factor authentication.



- Proof of U.S. citizenship or legal residency for all household members.
- Proof of disability, if applicable.
 Physician documentation noting that cooling assistance is needed for a household member's health, if there isn't a member older than the age of

Ohioans enrolled in the Percentage of Income Payment Plan (PIPP) Plus program who meet the above criteria may also be eligible for central air conditioning repairs, or may receive an air conditioning unit and/or fan.




