DR ROGERS WRITES, "I WANT YOU TO NOTICE SEVERAL THINGS ABOUT THIS PASSAGE OF SCRIPTURE. FIRST, I WANT YOU TO NOTICE WHEN WE SHOULD BE THANKFUL. WE ARE TO GIVE THANKS ALWAYS. IF PAUL HAD SAID *SOMETIMES*, THAT WOULDN'T BE SO HARD. BUT HE CLEARLY SAYS ALWAYS. NOW IT'S THANKSGIVING DAY, BUT YOU AND I BOTH KNOW THAT ONE DAY IS NOT ENOUGH. PSALM 68:19 SAYS, "BLESSED BE THE LORD, WHO DAILY LOADS US WITH BENEFITS..." EVERY DAY YOU GET A FRESH LOAD. YOU SHOULD NEVER PRAY WITHOUT THANKING GOD.
