

Benefits of using a NFA Gun Trust.

- You will not need to have your fingerprints done to submit them with the Form #4 when you send it to the BATF.
- You will not need to submit two photos with the Form #4 when you send it to the BATF.
- You do not need to get your local CLEO(Chief Law Enforcement Officer) to sign your Form #4 before sending it to BATF. (Sometimes an issue in some areas)
- It may speed up the approval process of your Form #4 by the BATF and FBI since they don't need to process your fingerprints. Also can possibly submit electronically via ATF eForms website.
- Allows you to name more than one person as being allowed to have possession of the NFA items owned by your trust. (your spouse, adult children) This allows you to protect yourself and your family from Constructive Possession, which is a violation of the NFA.
- Allows you to sell the entire trust with the NFA items to another person without another transfer tax.
- Allows you to name who you want to have control of your NFA items in the event of your death by them taking control of the trust and it's owned property.
- You can add or remove approved users of the NFA items at a later time. (Family members or friends)
- There are other benefit that can be found online if you research NFA Gun Trust.
