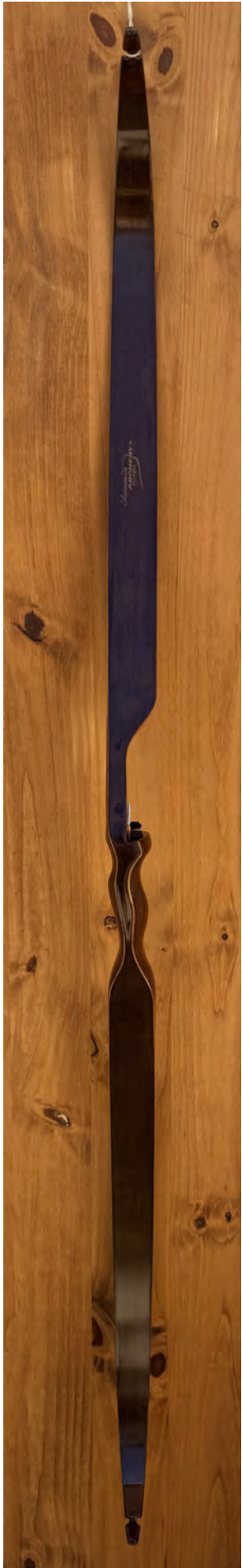

DESCRIPTION: Like most Shakespeare models, this one is a great shooter. Imbuaya riser. Comfortable grip but a bit thinner grip than other Shakespeare models. Bow has no delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. Overlays and tips are in great condition. There were 4 drilled holes which have been filled—two on the back for a sight, and 2 in the sight window (see pics on pages 5 and 6). They are only visible close-up. No chips or cracks. No crazing. The limbs show some wear and tear in the form of light oxidation and discoloration (see pic on page 4), and a few superficial stress lines (no cracks). A few minor scratches, dings and nicks here and there. Decals are in fair condition. Because of the limb wear and discoloration, the bow was put to extended stress test (held at full draw for 30 hours) to make sure the old glues held and no stress cracks developed. Then it was taken to the range and test shot. Comes with an authentic Shakespeare arrow rest and a replicas side plate, and a like new (but slightly used) string.
