The Friends of Pennypacker Mills cordially invite you to participate in our **13th annual Craft Marketplace** at Pennypacker Mills. The event is to be held on Saturday, September 14, 2024, at the mansion (address above) from 9:30 AM to 3 PM.

Since our first event in 2012 our following has grown considerably, and we have repeatedly won the Montco Happening List's Best in Montco award. In our first year, we featured 33 artisans and had 350 visitors. We have grown to consistently fill our capacity of 111 vendor spaces and attract more than 2,800 visitors. We receive enthusiastically positive feedback from both vendors and visitors.

This is the Friends' primary fundraising event. We are an all-volunteer organization, so except for a few very small administrative costs, all registration fees go towards funding educational programs, restoration projects and museum accessions at the Pennypacker Mills historic site. We appreciate the support you provide by participating in our event.

We have 111 spaces to rent out on a **first-come, first-served basis**. We do keep a waiting list, and we do call up quite a few folks from that list. Nevertheless, it is smart to sign up early as last year we sold out in mid-February.

We have a few options:

- you can rent a space only and provide your own 10' x 10' tent and tables (**preferred**);
- you can reserve a space under our tent space (limited to 25 spaces);
- you can rent a table to add to either type of space (very limited).

**Everyone must provide their own chairs.**

During the event, we provide coffee to get you started in the morning, and coverage at your booth when you need a break. Restrooms are in the brick building adjacent to the Craft Marketplace. We also have a food vendor on site.

The profits from this sale will benefit Pennypacker Mills, a popular Montgomery County-owned historical site which is located at the intersections of Routes 29 and 73 in Schwenksville. It is open to the public and visited annually by over 15,000 people. The Friends' sole purpose is to assist and support the mission and activities of Pennypacker Mills by working in cooperation with the site staff, Montgomery County, and other interested parties.

Established in 2010, our non-profit group has held many fund-raising activities which enabled the purchase of a pump for the History Center, the acquisition of Galusha Pennypacker artifacts, the paint analysis needed to restore the servant area, refurbishing the main parking lot garden beds, creation of a video tour of the second floor so that the handicapped who cannot climb our stairs are able to virtually enjoy the experience, and the purchase of a number of informational signs located at places of interest around the site. We also sponsor many events at the site.
