CONTEST UPDATES:

Contestants are required to bring:

- their own computer and must be able to print to a PDF
- USB Jump Drive

NOTE:

Computer set-up will begin at 8:00 am. Students must have their stations set-up and ready by 10:00 am.

There are no computer requirements that I have established, whatever computer program is used in the student's classroom is fine.

Contestants will start with a blank screen; the project package will give the contestant the border and title block information. From the project package, the contestant will turn in a working drawing fully dimensioned. There is no requirement for a space model. The judges will only score the paper drawing turned in at the end of the contest.

The contestants will be asked, once their drawings are turned in and signed by them with their contestant number providing evidence, if this is the drawing they want judged.

Contestants will be given 3 opportunities to print. If they are still unable to print they will not receive a score.

Before the contestant leaves the contest area, upon completion of their project, they will be requested to delete their project from their computer. This will be part of the instructions of the project. Failing to delete the project from their computer will result in a reduction of points.

Contestants will be given 4 hours to complete the drawing package.
