

Just the Facts

"Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today, and forever"
(Hebrews 13:8).

The Bible is not about fantasies, theories or good ideas. God reveals Himself to us through His Word, and the Bible is a message filled with love and hope. God's Word contains literally thousands of promises (facts) and God wants us to embrace some facts today.

The word fact means - something that truly exists or happens.

Fact- God never changes. In fact, it is impossible for God to change. All of us are prone to make assumptions based on our own understanding. But the kingdom of heaven isn't based on our personal set of assumptions, it's based on WHO HE IS and the facts concerning Him never change!

FACT- You are deeply loved by God and He will never abandon you. Nothing can tear you from the grip of His mighty love (Romans 8:38-39).

FACT- There are NO losers in the Kingdom of God. When you really think about it, winners have simply formed the habit of doing things losers don't like to do. It is the cross that makes us to be winners. "While we were still sinners, Christ died for us" (Rom 5:8).

Let your faith be bigger than whatever you are facing. We can overcome anything by keeping our eyes on HIM. If we focus our eyes on Him and not look at things or other people--- we will overcome! "He that overcomes shall inherit all things; and I will be his God, and he shall be mine " (Revelation 2:17).

What we could never do for ourselves is accomplished through a single touch from God. Do you need a touch from God today my friends? Keep your focus on Him. He loves you! SAY THIS: I will focus my attention on God instead of on myself and my problems.

"Life is about 10% of what happens to us and 90% of how we react to it" (John Maxwell). May the Lord help us react in the right way! What ever you are trusting HIM for, WAIT FOR IT. Don't quit. Don't stop trusting HIM. "Guard the good deposit that was entrusted to you—guard it with the help of the Holy Spirit who lives in you." (2 Timothy 1:14)

FACT- When your faith grows dim, cling to the truth that God will not fail you. When you feel yourself giving up, turn to the ONE who never breaks HIS promise..... and know that you can believe HIM. For no matter how many promises God has made, they are "Yes" in Christ. And so through him the "Amen" is spoken by us to the glory of God (2 Corinthians 1:20)

God wants us to live life on the reality of who He is and what He has said. Faith is what enables us to be certain that we can trust Him. Life is a gift that God gave you for a reason. You have a purpose.

Jesus is waiting for you. You are His beloved. Receive all that which He has so lovingly provided. He is the God of "more than enough", who has never broken a promise in all eternity, and He certainly isn't going to start with you.

Lord, I agree that you are my God. I agree that I need you in my life. I agree that as I continually follow after You, I will see Your purposes established in my life. Lord, I agree that situations in my life may seem unfair, but You are my vindicator. I know that You will not forsake the work of Your hands within me.
