Aloha Kakou,

This is the time of year when I sit back and ponder our congregation's direction, purpose, and strategy. Actually, I think about it all the time but more so in January/February.

What has struck me this past year is that many people my age and younger have grown up in a so-called "Christian culture" that I am totally unfamiliar with. Call it what you will - fundamentalism, evangelicalism, "Christian" - many people have been born into, enculturated, and discipled into a type of Christianity that I know little to nothing about. And I think I know a lot! Their music, theology, worship, ethics, and faith-training are profoundly different from what I was raised in and what I now live with.

What I do know is that many of these Christian people have become disenchanted with their form of immersive Christianity and are looking for something different, something new. As I look around, our somewhat traditional Protestant faith is totally unknown to the majority of young Christians. What we have to offer has become mind-boggling to the #exvangelicals (the Ex-Evangelicals) who have abandoned their churches en masse, often due to the stridency of their denominations regarding issues in the culture wars, pastoral/elder abuse, and stunning forms of public shaming.

The pandemic and the climate catastrophes have changed everything, both in church and culture. What they have not changed is our core, the Gospel of Jesus - in Christ God has drawn near to us, loved us, forgiven us, rescued us. Through Word and sacrament the Holy Spirit restores us, nourishes us, and gives us the courage to speak loving truth to power.

If you meet an #Exvangelical discouraged or wounded by their church, who thinks they may have lost their faith and state of grace, be kind to them. Listen to their pain. And maybe, when the time is right, invite them to join us in worship.

CLC is a safe place, a comforting and encouraging gathering of good people trying to understand what following Jesus means, a communion of saints and sinners alike. I think we need to let people know there are alternatives to their experience of church. And that we are that alternative.

Farewell Chaplain Mark!


