Koline - Sunday, February 8, 2015



January 11th - Baraga dinner - All proceeds go to the Baraga Association for his sainthood process.

Every 2nd Sunday of the month all families with school children are encouraged to attend the regular 11am Mass and actively participate with readings, petitions, and singing. After the Mass, a monthly dinner is served at the Cultural Center.

Blessing of the candles/ throats – On Sunday, **February 1st** there will be a blessing of the candles (which are usually blessed at the feast day of the Presentation of the Lord – February 2^{nd)} and the blessing of the throats (St. Blasé blessing) during the 11:00 am Mass.

Lent – starts with **Ash Wednesday, February 18th**. Every Sunday there will be devotions of the Stations of the Cross at 1:30 in the afternoon. afternoon (except on the Sundays of the Monthly dinner – stations will be at 2:30 pm). Non-perishable food items will be collected in the church for the local Food Pantry.

Friday, March 27th - making of the 'butarice' in the Center. Please, come and help! All proceeds will go to the missions.

Palm Sunday – March 29th – 11:00 am – The blessing of the 'butarice' and other greenery will be held at the Cultural Center. We will then process to the church. During the Mass, the solemn reading of Jesus' passion according to Mark will be read.

Holy Thursday – April 2nd - Jesus' last supper. Solemn Mass will be at 7:00 pm, after the Mass holy hour with Jesus in the 'jail'.

Good Friday – April 3rd – 3:00 pm Stations of the Cross (in English). At 7:00 pm will be Celebration of the Lord's Passion.

Holy Saturday-Vigil of Easter – April 4th – at 2:00 pm blessing of the food (which entail bread-meat; colored eggs, horse radish and 'potica'-walnut cake). At 7:00 pm will be a special liturgy of the day followed by a gathering in the Cultural Ceter.

Easter – April 5th – 11:00 am solemn Mass of Easter Sunday – Jesus' resurrection.

On Friday, March 27th, please join us in the small hall of the Cultural Center for our annual event of making **Butarice**. The Sunday before Easter we celebrate "Cvetna nedelja" meaning "Flower sunday", or "Palm sunday". On that day people come with "Butarice", "Butare" to church where they are blessed. Butarice are bundles of greenery & flowers & painted wood curls. Some people also put on oranges and apples. Home made Butarice are mostly made by greenery and flowers. We will begin at 8:30am. A light lunch will be served in thanks for your time and effort.



SLOVENIAN AMERICAN BUSINESS ASSOCIATION

On November 17th, 2014, the Slovenian American Business Association (SABA) hosted their 2nd Business Conference entitled "Slovenia: Business Opportunities for U.S. Companies" at the Slovenian Catholic Center in Lemont. Speakers at the conference included Jure Žmauc, Consul General of the Republic of Slovenia, Rudolf Krašovec, President of KSKJ, Jože Kokal, President of SABA, George Schafer, Representative from the Village of Lemont and Dr. Bozo Cerar, Slovenian Ambassador to the United States from Washington D.C.

The opening presentation, made by Jure Žmauc, on behalf of Gorazd Renčelj, the economic advisor to the Embassy of the Republic of Slovenia in Washington D.C., included an overview of the economic situation in Slovenia and its position and opportunities in the European Union.

Mr. Dean Kravos from the company HIDRIA located in Idrija, Slovenia spoke about ways for Slovenian companies to successfully conduct business in the U.S. CEO of MIK Celje, Franci Pliberšek, also spoke about the potential for Slovenian companies entering the U.S. market.

The second part of the conference included presentations by Dr. Peter Rožič from San Francisco, California, who discussed a program which brings students from the Republic of Slovenia to the U.S. for scientific training via the American English Education Foundation (ASEF). Professor Luka

Zibelnik from Cleveland State University also introduced his project called "Pocket Slovenian" which includes an online language course.

Other speakers and participants were able to see and discuss the importance of cooperation between Slovenian and American companies with an interest in entering alternative marketplaces.

SABA is a business trade association with an advisory board consisting of a Chairman and up to ten (10) geographically located Directors. The SABA board chairman and directors work in conjunction with the Consul General to the United States, the Republic of Slovenia, relevant Ministries of Slovenia, the U.S. State Department, the U.S. Department of Commerce, various U.S. state and local governments, the European Union, and SABA members to establish and deliver a variety of business programs, business information, contacts, and support tools to achieve the SABA mission to increase bilateral trade.

Meeting with Archbishop Fr. Stane Zore

During my recent trip to Slovenia, I had the honor and pleasure to see and meet with the new Archbishop, Stane Zore. The meeting was organized by our long-time friend, Fr. Christian Gostečnik. During our meeting with the Archbishop we had the opportunity to reminisce about his visit to our Cultural Center in Lemont where he blessed the Cross that hangs in the small hall of our Dom. Archbishop Zore sends his well wishes to everyone in Lemont and, on behalf of our community, I extended our congratulations to him on his recent appointment as Archbishop of Ljubljana.

Pope Francis appointed Stane Zore the new Ljubljana archbishop in October of last year. The Roman Catholic Church celebrated the appointment of the

new Ljubljana Archbishop; who is the first Franciscan monk to head the Ljubljana diocese in its more than 500 yearlong history. Stane Zore has headed the Slovenian Franciscan Province since 2010. In October when he was appointed to become the new Archbishop of Ljubljana by Pope Francis, he said he would try to strengthen the role of the Church in society and announced he would form a commission which would deal with burning issues between the Church and the state. Born in 1958 in Sela pri Kamniku, Archbishop Zore was ordained priest in 1985 after graduating at the Theological Faculty in Ljubljana. *Martina Hozjan Ruda*


