DIVISIONS

GREEN - 2' - Horses in their first or second year of showing

OPEN - 2'6"-2'9" - Open to all horses and riders

LIMIT - 2'5" - Open to non-professional riders

JUMPERS- 2'6" and 2'9" -Two rounds for each height division, optimal time format

LOW HUNTER - 2'3" - Open to non professional riders

PONY - 2' - Open to non professional riders with ponies 14.2 HH and under

NOVICE - 2' - Open to non professional riders in their **first or second year showing over fences OR haven't jumped higher than 2'3" at any horse show.**

CROSSRAIL - Open to non professional riders who are in their **first or second year of showing over fences AND who have not jumped higher than 2' at any shows.** You may trot or canter the crossrails. Flat classes are walk, trot, canter

WALK/TROT - Open to non professional riders who are in their **first year of showing** and/or who are not comfortable yet riding at the canter. To be shown walk and trot only. Ground poles classes will be trot only.

INFORMATION

*****All riders must have a signed entry form in the show office before schooling in any ring.**

Entry Fee \$15 per class

Negative Coggins required for all horses entering the property.

Stalls: \$55 for Friday night and Saturday: \$40 for Saturday only, if available. Stalls will be reserved with payment. First bedding provided. Stalls are limited.

Attire: This is a schooling show. Full attire is not required. Breeches, boots and riding shirt are recommended. Helmet is required. Half chaps are acceptable.

Schooling: Permitted Friday 2-8pm and Saturday dawn-7:30am. Ring closes at 7:30am sharp Saturday to water and drag. **NO SCHOOLING WITHOUT A SIGNED LIABILITY WAIVER**

Awards: First place prize and ribbons awarded through sixth place. All leadliners will receive a prize. Management reserves the right to divide, cancel or combine classes. High Point Champion and Reserve ribbon for each division. In the event of a tie, the Eq O/F class will be the tie breaker. Divisions without an Eq class will use the Hunter O/F as the tie breaker.

Professionals allowed in green horse and open classes only. "Professional" refers to anyone acting in an instructional position accepting payment for training.

All judge's decisions are final. Judge will be asked not to place anyone using a martingale or other head setting device in flat classes. Hunter pace will be emphasized over the number of strides in over fences classes. Extreme speed will be penalized. Boots and other special equipment/tack are only permitted at the judge's discretion.

Trainers/Parents are responsible for making sure riders are entered in the correct classes for their abilities.

Thomet Stables, it's management, employees and/or other horse show officials will not be held responsible for any accidents, damage or loss
