# Public Library Regular Meeting March 6, 2018 MINUTES

## I) Call meeting to Order and Establish a Quorum

#### II) Action Items

Approval of Minutes of November 14, 2017
 Motion made by Mike Holloway to approve minutes, seconded by Bart Bodine, motion carried.

#### **III) Information Reports**

1. Advisory Board and Director Concerns
Jeanie Coleman asked about adding someone to the board, which was discussed at previous meetings due to the two members moving in the near future. They are not moving at this time, so the board will return to this issue when necessary.

## 2. Financial and Statistical Reports

After a review of the Statement of Revenue and Expenditures to date, a question was raised about the line item for the security system. This cost was due to repairs made to the library's system, which in turn was made necessary due to the City's phone system switching to VOIP. The cellular service the security system used after the landline removal was not consistently sending a signal, so an external antenna was added.

### 3. Director's Report

- a. Alternate payments for fines
  We have long allowed "alternate payment" with food for fines, working off fines,
  donations of DVDs, etc. We now plan to offer the option to juvenile patrons to
  read down fines. They can read while in the library to reduce their fine at the
  staff's discretion.
- b. Library of Things grant
  This would be an expansion of our STEAM Kits, with items such as a metal detector, Raspberry Pi kit, sewing machines, etc. The director will be seeking funding from The Tocker and/or Hancher Foundations.
