Jumper Division Class Specifications

Intro To Show Jumping Poles

Open to riders 10 years and under /horses or ponies

Intro to Show Jumping Cross rails

Open to riders 14 years and under / horses or ponies

Puddle Jumper

Open to all riders and horse or ponies. Fence Height: 2'

Beginner Novice Jumper

Open to children and adult amateurs in their first or second year of showing in the jumpers at 2'6" or higher as of December first, of the current year. Riders may only cross enter into Novice Jumpers, if eligible, thoroughbred and Low Jumpers. Fence Height 2'3"-6" with spreads no less than 2'3" and no greater than 2'6"

Novice Jumper

Open to horses or ponies in their 1st or 2nd year of showing in jumper classes at 2'6" or higher as of December first, of the current year. Horses or ponies may only cross enter Novice-Children's/Adult Amateur Jumpers, if eligible, Thoroughbred and Low Jumpers. Fence Height: 2'3"-2'6", with spreads no less than 2'3" and no greater than 2'6"

Low Jumper

Open to horses and ponies no restrictions on riders (Exceptions: See Novice Jumper and Novice Child/Adult Jumper.) Fence Height: 2'9' with spreads no less than 2'6" and no greater than fence height.

Children's/Adult Amateur Jumpers

Open to horses or ponies ridden by junior & adult amateur riders. No cross entering with the Novice Child/Adult Amateur Jumper. Fence Height: 3'0" with spreads no less than 2'6" and no greater than the height of the fence.

Schooling Jumper

Open to horses and ponies. No restrictions on riders. Fence Height 3'3"-3'6" with spreads no less than 3' and no greater than the height of the fence.

Table II, Sec. 1 (Time First Round)

The first round is decided by adding together the faults incurred over the course and any penalties for exceeding the Time Allowed if any. Horses with clean rounds or equal faults will be classified according to their time taken to complete the course.

- ❖ A negative Coggins is required.
- ❖ Hard hats are required while mounted.
- ❖ The large ring will be open for schooling at 7:30 AM. The small ring will be available for schooling all day.
- ❖ The show manager reserves the right to combine or cancel classes if there are insufficient entries.
- ❖ Returned checks will be assessed a \$25 charge.
- ❖ Ribbon will be awarded to 6th place
- ❖ Class entry fees are \$25 per class
- ❖ There is a grounds/office fee of \$25 per horse. .
- ❖ Juniors and adults may ride ponies.
