

Dear Friends in Christ,

Be merciful to me, LORD, for I am faint; O LORD, heal me, for my bones are in agony. My soul is in anguish. How long, O LORD, how long? (Psalm 6:2-3).

This letter is unlike what I have ever written. In 15+ years of ministry, I've written over 175 letters, some more difficult and challenging than others. But normally (!), as a church family approaches Palm Sunday, Holy Week, and Easter, the content is essentially the same.

Not this year! Social distancing! Self-isolation! Abundance of caution! How many verses of *Happy Birthday* have you sung? We are not together! We miss each other! Our lives are in disarray! Our health is under threat! We won't be able to celebrate Jesus' Passion and Resurrection together! No full sanctuary with joyous hymns this year! We cry out to God, "How long, O LORD, how long?"

Are not two sparrows sold for a penny? Yet not one of them will fall to the ground apart from the will of your Father. And even the very hairs of your head are all numbered (Matthew 10:29-30).

My friends, God DOES hear our cries, and is with us during these difficult times. He knows what we are going through, and for whatever reason, he has allowed this to happen. Our world is broken – evil, sickness, and pain are part of our lives. During these difficult days we must rely upon and lean upon the Lord for comfort, provision, and hope. We must remain faithful and patient.

The Mars leadership team has stepped up and in! Our Elders and Deacons are reaching out to others – whose name has been placed on YOUR heart? I hope you've been able to see our Virtual Worship Service – as I write this, the March 22 service had 199 "views," and the 29th had 73. This means others outside our own family are hearing the Word. (A comment from the 29th – I am not used to preaching from a wooden chair!) We also encourage you to join the Virtual Tarry & Talk each Sunday at 11:00.

[The] men said to them, "Why do you look for the living among the dead? He is not here; he has risen! (Luke 24:5-6).

Almost 2,000 years ago, terrified, grieving women went to a tomb – where they would care for the body of a dead friend. Those of us who have lost loved ones can imagine their grief and loss. But instead of finding their dead friend, two men in dazzling clothes gave them the greatest news ever received. He is not here; he has risen!

My friends, because of the risen Christ, we need not search among dead things for hope and assurance. Because Christ has been raised, we also can rise above any trial or tribulation. We must set our hope in the Lord, and remain hopeful and positive about the future. Because Jesus is alive – not dead – we also are alive.

I pray that, whatever the circumstances, you have a prayerful Holy Week and a joyous Easter. We WILL be back together, and having gone through this ordeal, we will resume worship and fellowship stronger than ever! Because *He is not here; he has risen!*








Centers for Disease Control and Prevention website gives the steps to prevent illness for the coronavirus disease 2019 (Covid-19). There is currently no vaccine.

The best way to prevent illness is to avoid being exposed to this virus. The virus is spread mainly person-to-person, between people who are in close contact with one another (within about 6 feet). Through respiratory droplets produced when an infected person coughs or sneezes. Steps to protect yourself are the following: 1) Clean your hands often. 2) Avoid close contact. 3) Stay home if you're sick. 4) Cover coughs and sneezes. 5) Wear a facemask if you are sick 6) Clean and disinfect frequently touched surfaces daily. This includes tables, doorknobs, light switches, countertops, handles, desks, phones, keyboards, toilets, faucets, and sinks. If surfaces are dirty, clean them.



A question to ponder...... In the storms of life, Will you walk in Fear or Faith?


- 1. Storms are an inevitable part of life.
