

Holy Scripture

RESPONSIVE PSALM - Psalm 68. 1-4, 32-35 [NRSV]

Let God rise up, let His enemies be scattered;

Let those who hate Him flee before Him.

As smoke is driven away, so drive them away; as wax Melts before the fire,

Let the wicked perish before God.

But let the righteous be joyful; let them exult before God;

Let them be jubilant with joy.

Sing to God, sing praises to His Name;

lift up a song to Him who rides upon the clouds;

His Name is the Lord; be exultant before Him...

Sing to God, O kingdoms of the Earth; sing praises to the Lord,

O Rider in the heavens, the ancient heavens;

EPISTLE LESSON - 1 Corinthians 1.17-25 [NRSV]

For Christ did not send me to baptize but to proclaim the Gospel, and not with eloquent wisdom, so that the Cross of Christ might not be emptied of its power, for the message about the Cross is foolishness to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it is the power of God. For it is written, "I will destroy the wisdom of the wise and the discernment of the discerning I will thwart." Where is the one who is wise? Where is the Scribe? Where is the debater of this age? Has not God made foolish the wisdom of the world? Since, in the wisdom of God, the world did not know God through wisdom, God decided, through the foolishness of our proclamation, to save those who believe. Jews demand signs and Greeks desire wisdom, but we proclaim Christ crucified, a stumbling block to Jews and foolishness to Gentiles, but to those who are the called, both Jews and Greeks, Christ [is] the power of God and the wisdom of God. For God's foolishness is wiser than human wisdom, and God's weakness is stronger than human strength.

GOSPEL LESSON - Luke 21.9, 25-28 [NRSV]

"When you hear of wars and insurrections, do not be terrified; for these things must take place first, but the end will not follow immediately." Then he said to them, "Nation will rise against nation and kingdom against kingdom; there will be great earthquakes and in various places famines and plagues; there will be dreadful portents and great signs from Heaven...There will be signs in the sun, the moon, and the stars, and on the Earth distress among nations confused by the roaring of the sea and the waves. People will faint from fear and foreboding of what is coming upon the world, for the powers of the heavens will be shaken. Then they will see 'the Son of Man coming in a cloud' with power and great glory. Now when these things begin to take place, stand up and raise your heads, because your redemption is drawing near."

CONFESSION OF FAITH - The Nicene Creed
