## Block 12

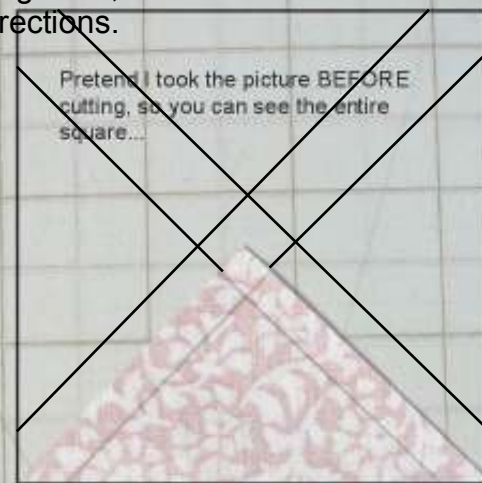
### Alternate Handle Instructions

(Replaces 3 paragraphs on page 1 under the heading "Handles")

Cut (2) 3 1/4" pink squares, draw diagonal lines 1/4" from center in both directions, then cut both ways. You'll only use 6 pieces.

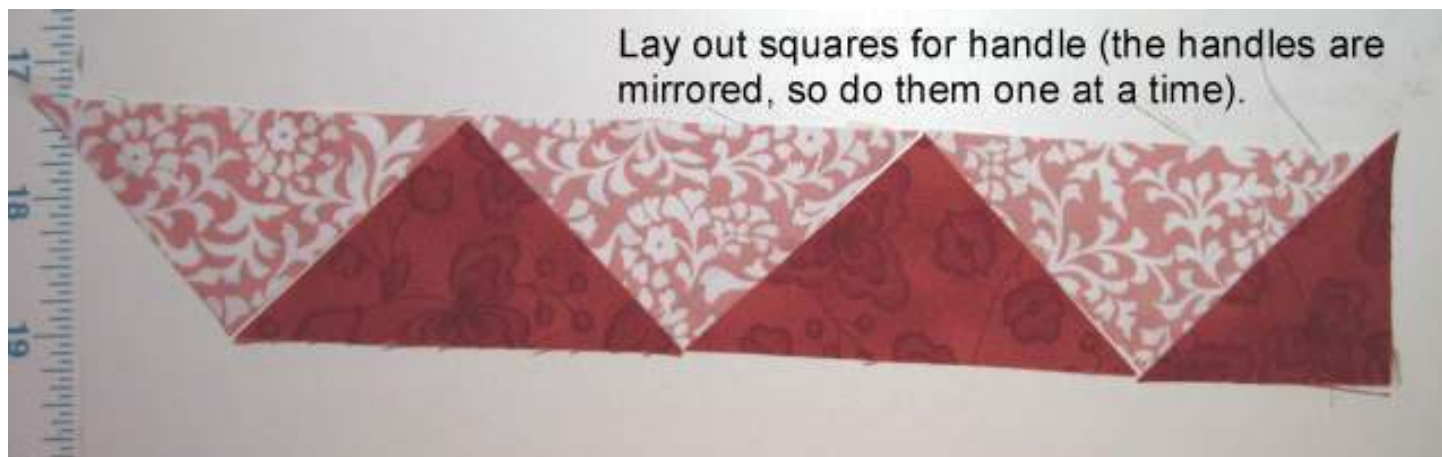


Draw diagonal line 1/4" from center along both diagonals, then cut between them in both directions.

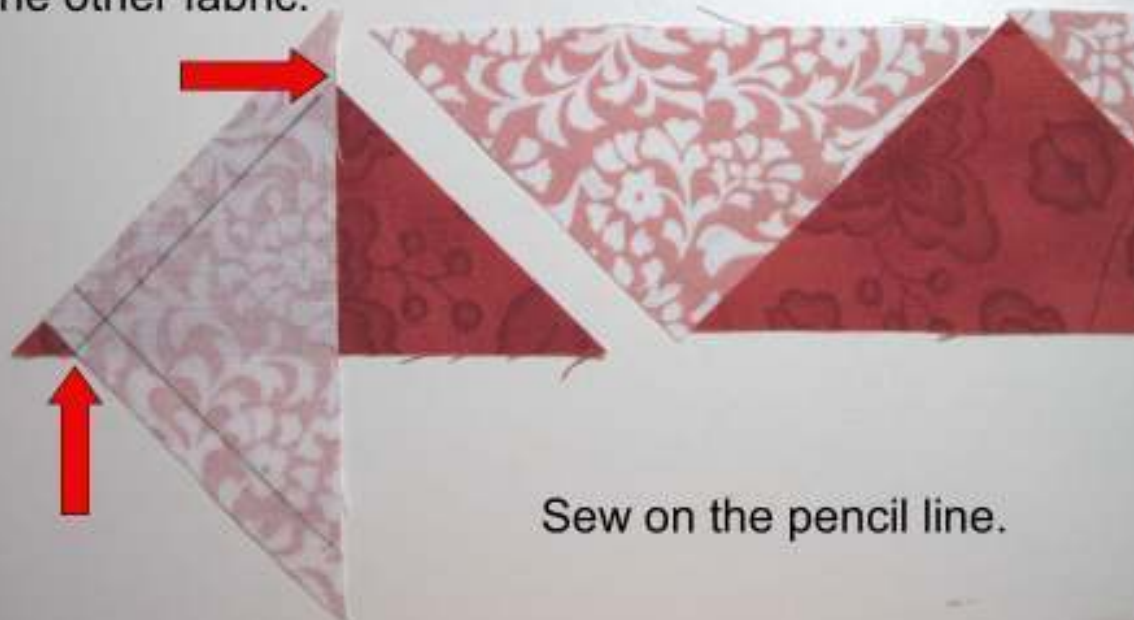


Cut (1) 3 1/4" red square, then cut diagonally both ways.

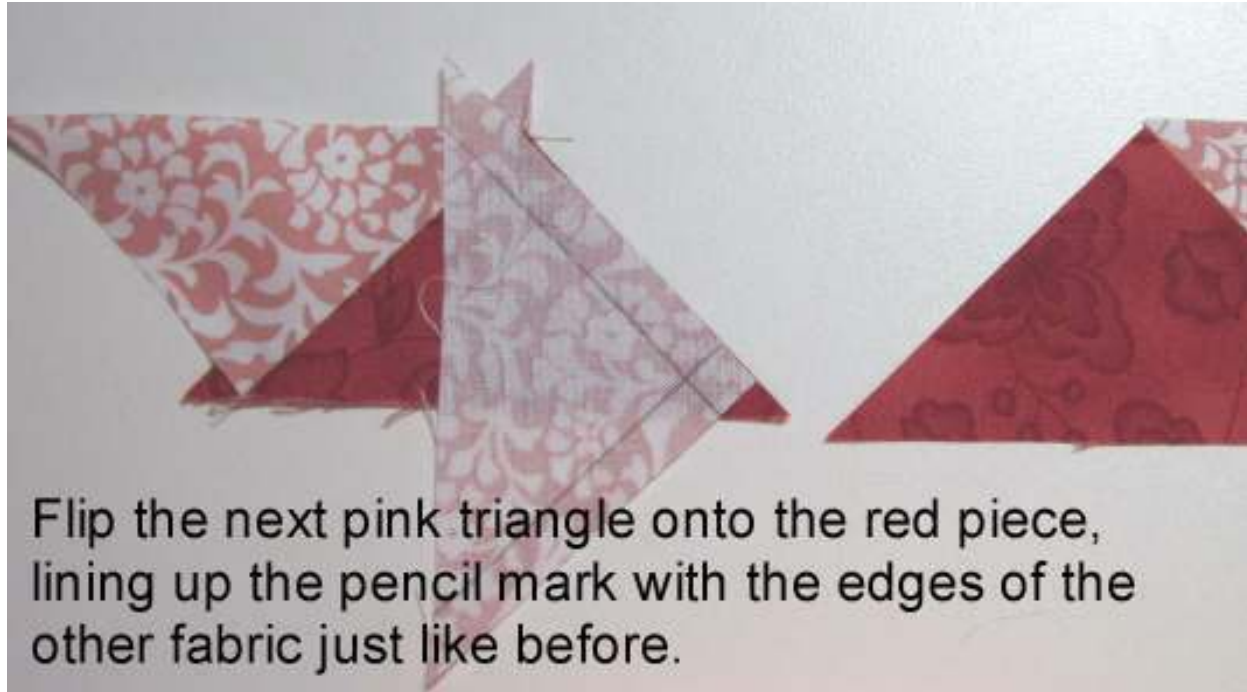
Cut (1) 1 7/8" red square, then cut diagonally ONE way.



Flip first triangle over onto second triangle, lining up the pencil mark with the edges of the other fabric.



Next time I'll press  
to the red



Flip the next pink triangle onto the red piece,  
lining up the pencil mark with the edges of the  
other fabric just like before.

Seam ends right  
in the corner





Straight and even



But I still should have pressed to the red...

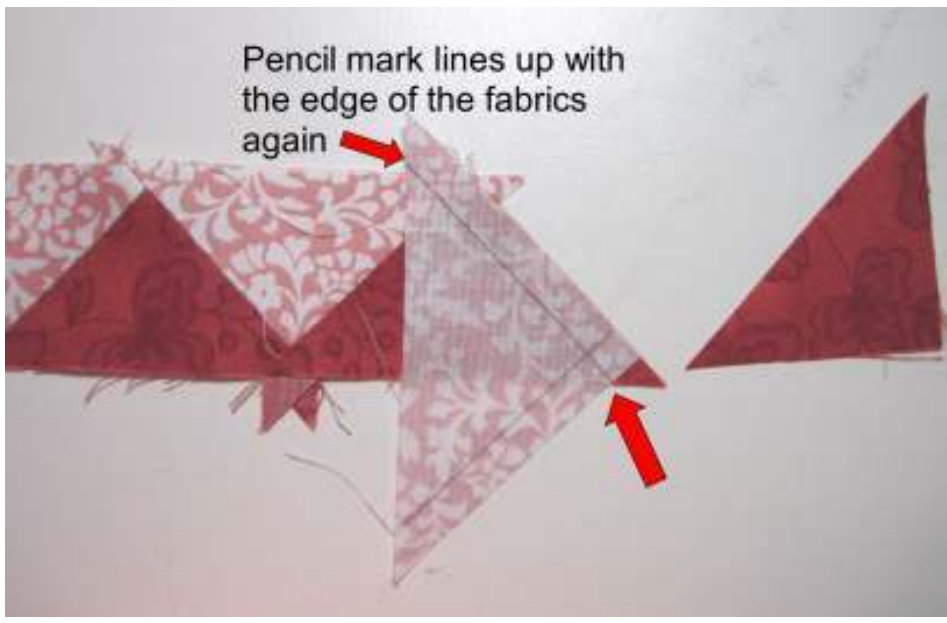
Pencil line even with corner  
and edge of fabric (okay,  
almost...)



Press to the red



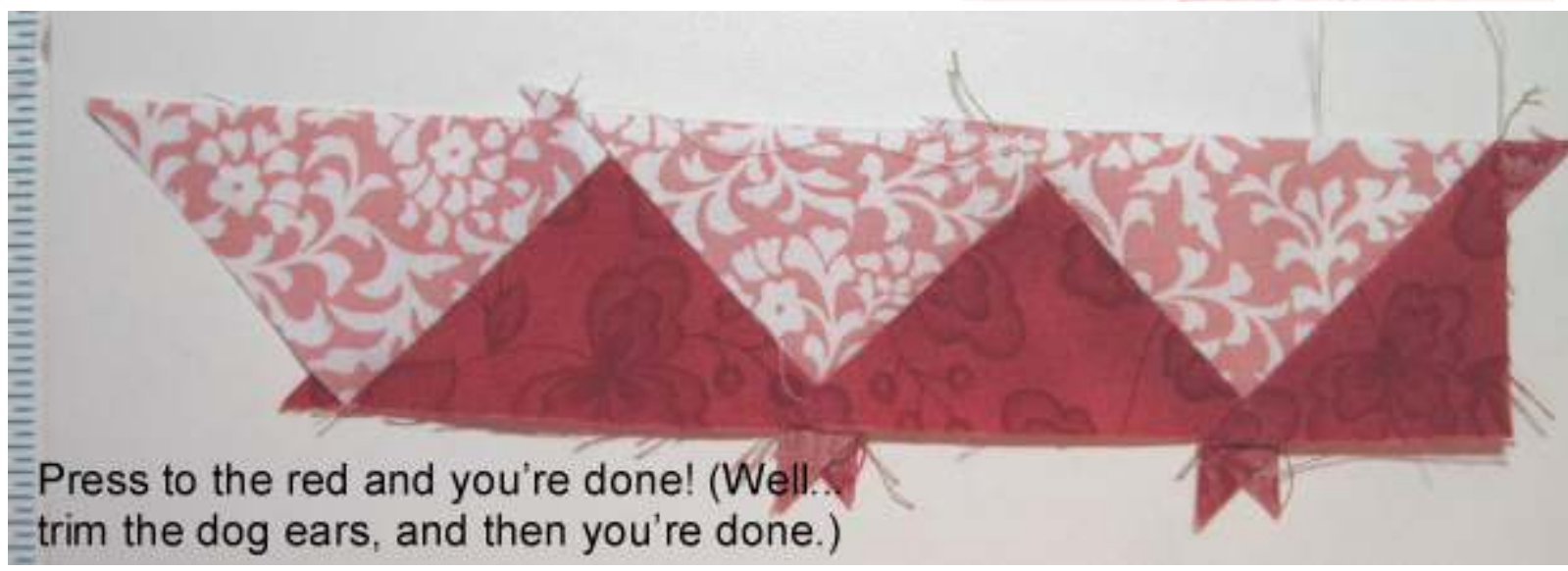
Pencil mark lines up with the edge of the fabrics again



Corners line up exactly.



It's hard to see, but the last triangle is underneath



Press to the red and you're done! (Well... trim the dog ears, and then you're done.)

**When you do the other handle, remember that it is mirrored, like this:**
