

TOURNAMENT RULES

1. A court monitor will be present at each set of courts to assign matches and to record scores. They will NOT be in charge of making official rulings. USTA officials will be responsible for all official rulings.
2. Matches will consist of 2 out of 3 sets. Failure to be on time for a match will result in the proper penalty as stated in the 2015 USTA rule book. In case of ties, individual matches will use the 12 point tiebreaker.
3. All tennis rules will be strictly enforced.
4. Gate admission will be charged for all high school activities tournaments including the West Region and State tennis tournaments.

PURPOSE

To elevate standards of good sportsmanship and to encourage the growth of responsible citizenship among the students, member schools, and their personnel.

FUNDAMENTALS OF GOOD SPORTSMANSHIP

1. Know, appreciate, and understand the rules of the contest.
2. Show respect for the officials. Good Sportsmanship implies the willingness to accept and abide by the decisions of the officials.
3. Show respect for the opponent at all times. Good Sportsmanship is the Golden Rule in action.
4. Recognize and appreciate the skill of performance regardless of team affiliation.
5. Maintain self control at all times. Good Sportsmanship is a responsibility of all who are involved in the game.
6. Show a positive attitude in cheering, refraining from intimidation or negative cheering. Good Sportsmanship is cheering your own team "on to victory."

ACTS OF MISCONDUCT

1. Throwing of any objects onto the playing floor or in the stands.
2. Behavior deemed dangerous or which interferes with the rights of others to watch the game.
3. Possessing, consuming, or being under the influence of chemicals.
4. Use of obscene, profane, or abusive language or gestures, signs, posters, or banners, which show disrespect for opponent's team, officials, cheerleaders, band, or other performing groups.
5. The use of noisemakers.
6. Entry onto the playing surface at any time.
