Wisdom:

Wisdom from God is the ability to navigate the world. It is the wise attitude, belief, or course of action that guides us to God's Peace and Happiness.

In this world we are confronted with many things that need Godly wisdom to be able to choose wisely and have successful plans. God knows this so what does He say to do that gains this needed Wisdom? Ask. If you need Wisdom you are to just ask and it will be given unto you. God will once you, ask impart into your heart His Direction, Understanding and Guidance for you to navigate yourself to a successful and peaceful plan. We don't even need to qualify to get this gift of Wisdom other than just ask for it.

The challenge for some is that when you ask for Wisdom you must then receive it. Receiving from God is only possible when you use His method:

1. You must be seeking His Will and Path for your life.
2. You must receive it by faith, with joy, knowing He will do what He said. Your assurance comes from knowing that God is faithful to His Word. (Mark 11:22-24)
3. You must then respond with a corresponding action. Not just hearing instruction but then also doing what Wisdom instructs.

Scriptures:

James 1:2-6 ^(AMP)

² *Consider it wholly joyful, my brethren, whenever you are enveloped in or encounter trials of any sort or fall into various temptations.*

³ *Be assured and understand that the trial and proving of your faith bring out endurance and steadfastness and patience.*

⁴ *But let endurance and steadfastness and patience have full play and do a thorough work, so that you may be [people] perfectly and fully developed [with no defects], lacking in nothing.*

⁵ *If any of you is deficient in wisdom, let him ask of the giving God [Who gives] to everyone liberally and ungrudgingly, without reproaching or faultfinding, and it will be given him.*

⁶ *Only it must be in faith that he asks with no wavering (no hesitating, no doubting). For the one who wavers (hesitates, doubts) is like the billowing surge out at sea that is blown hither and thither and tossed by the wind.*

James 4:7-10 ^(AMP)

⁷ *So be subject to God. Resist the devil [stand firm against him], and he will flee from you.*

⁸ *Come close to God and He will come close to you. [Recognize that you are] sinners, get your soiled hands clean; [realize that you have been disloyal] wavering individuals with divided interests, and purify your hearts [of your spiritual adultery].*

⁹ *[As you draw near to God] be deeply penitent and grieve, even weep [over your disloyalty]. Let your laughter be turned to grief and your mirth to dejection and heartfelt shame [for your sins].*

¹⁰ *Humble yourselves [feeling very insignificant] in the presence of the Lord, and He will exalt you [He will lift you up and make your lives significant].*

Matthew 6:9-13 ^(AMP)

⁹ *Pray, therefore, like this: Our Father Who is in heaven, hallowed (kept holy) be Your name.*

¹⁰ *Your kingdom come, Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven.*

¹¹ *Give us this day our daily bread.*

¹² *And forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven (left, remitted, and let go of the debts, and have given up resentment against) our debtors.*

¹³ *And lead (bring) us not into temptation, but deliver us from the evil one. For Yours is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever. Amen.*

Psalms 23 ^(AMP)

¹ *The Lord is my Shepherd [to feed, guide, and shield me], I shall not lack.*

² *He makes me lie down in [fresh, tender] green pastures; He leads me beside the still and restful waters.*

³ *He refreshes and restores my life (myself); He leads me in the paths of righteousness [uprightness and right standing with Him—not for my earning it, but] for His name’s sake.*

⁴ *Yes, though I walk through the [deep, sunless] valley of the shadow of death, I will fear or dread no evil, for You are with me; Your rod [to protect] and Your staff [to guide], they comfort me.*

⁵ *You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies. You anoint my head with oil; my [brimming] cup runs over.*

⁶ *Surely or only goodness, mercy, and unfailing love shall follow me all the days of my life, and through the length of my days the house of the Lord [and His presence] shall be my dwelling place.*

John 14:27 ^(AMP)

Peace I leave with you; My [own] peace I now give and bequeath to you. Not as the world gives do I give to you. Do not let your hearts be troubled, neither let them be afraid. [Stop allowing yourselves to be

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agitated and disturbed; and do not permit yourselves to be fearful and intimidated and cowardly and unsettled.]

Confessions:

1. Read the above Scriptures aloud and place yourself in each Scripture as if it was written just for you. Be like Jesus and say "It is written!"

2. Confess aloud:
 - a. "Father, I look to You to give me the Wisdom that I need to guide my life."
 - b. "I declare, I have the Wisdom of God active in my life and will no longer say 'I don't know what to do'."
 - c. "I submit to Your Way of Doing and Being. I choose to Trust in Your Word above all else even as I walk through the valley of the shadow of death."
 - d. "Satan I resist you, your thoughts of fear, pressure and confusion knowing God Himself has Promised that I now have His Wisdom, Protection, Provision and Peace."
 - e. "Father, I choose to Trust Your Word more than all else and will walk out Your Instruction in joy, patience and assurance that the Most High God Loves and Cares for me!"

Prayer:

"Father, I bow my knee to Your Will, Instructions and Path for my life. I receive by faith the Grace You have given me and ask for You to impart Wisdom for me to navigate my life. I thank You for this Grace and Wisdom and resist all thoughts contrary to what Your Word says.

Today I stand on top of confusion, failure and walk through the "valley of the shadow of death". Today I will dominate satan through the Power and Mercy You have given me in Jesus' Salvation. This I pray in the Mighty Name of Jesus Christ, to Him be all the Glory!"
