Presiding Commissioner, Kyle Carroll, West District Commissioner, Kyle White, East District Commissioner, Chet Owen and County Clerk, Melissa Meek.

Presiding Commissioner, Kyle Carroll welcomed those in attendance and led all in prayer. The Pledge of Allegiance was then recited by all in attendance.

County Clerk, Melissa Meek presented fund balances to the Commission for them to review. All funds look good currently. Melissa also presented sales tax reports with all those funds coming in above average.

Joseph McLiney of McLiney & Company met with the Commission to discuss refinancing the building note to have yearly payments and a lower interest rate. Payments will continue to be made with USE Tax funds and will save the County a generous amount of money. Joseph will return to the Commission as soon as he gets financing in place.

Collector/Treasurer Jessica Lee presented the adjustment register for June for the Commission and Clerk to review and sign.

Attorney Travis Elliott sent documentation for signage to be placed at the Fairgrounds concerning usage and insurance requirements. Melissa will take that to the printer for signs to be made and then will be placed at the Fairgrounds.
