

### **Tournament News**

### October Tournament Recap and Season Update

Our first tournament of the season is officially in the books! I'm happy to report that this year's October 2-Man Better Ball Tournament kicked off with 104 players (52 teams) registered. Our final count came to 50½ teams competing across



our usual four flights. The "½ team" resulted from a partner no-show, requiring a blind draw replacement. Additionally, our B Flight lost one full team due to a no-show, which slightly reduced the field.

The club paid out a total of \$2,795 to our flight winners (win, place, and show) and \$2,032 for Closest to the Pin and Our 50/50 winners—Ralph Alderete, Luis Sanchez, and Lyle Ferguson—split the \$390 pot, and Steve the Free Round of Harlin won Congratulations to all the winners and thank you to everyone who participated!

### Pace of Play Reminder

We need to address pace of play once again. During the tournament, I received three text messages about slow play while on the course. This message is not meant to debate or single anyone out, but rather to ensure that everyone enjoys their round at a reasonable pace.

#### Please remember:

- **Look ahead.** Are you waiting on every shot? If not, you may be the cause of a delay.
- Look behind. Are the groups behind you always waiting on the tee box or fairway for your group to finish? You're likely the problem. Work to get your group back into position. Let's all do our part to keep things moving smoothly for everyone.

#### **Tuesday Skins Update**

Board Member Tim Sleeger will serve as our Tuesday Skins Coordinator for the new season, with me as his backup. You will continue to receive Tuesday invites from Golf Genius under my name, but please direct any texts or emails outside of Golf Genius regarding Tuesday Skins directly to Tim.

#### Next Tournament - Individual Low Net

Our next EPMC Tournament is the Individual Low Net, scheduled for Saturday, November 15th. Watch for the upcoming Golf Genius signup email and register early to secure your spot. Zelle advance tournament payment option will be available.

We'll confirm the player roster via email on Wednesday, November 12th, and release tee times and pairings on Friday, November 14th.

This is an **individual event**, and **each player must sign up in Golf Genius** personally.

### **Registration Steps:**

- 1. In the signup email, scroll to the bottom and click **Playing** or **Not Playing** to confirm.
- If you'd like, you can send a message to the manager with a request for an early or late tee time. There are no pairing requests for this event as it is an individual competition.
- 3. Click **SEND** to complete your registration.

The Golf Genius tee sheet link will automatically display confirmed players. We'll monitor signups closely and communicate directly if any issues arise. Registered players will also receive an automated confirmation email from Golf Genius.



### **Skins News**

Members are always inquiring about different aspects of the skins games that we run on Tuesday and Saturday. I wanted to give everyone an idea on how and why we do what we do.





website. Go to the <u>El Prado Men's Club</u> home page, and in the green banner across the top is the link labeled "<u>Rules</u>". Once you click on that you can view our local rules along with many others regarding nearly all our events.

I will address some of the other common questions below:

### How do we determine formats to make it fair for everyone?

Our goal is to always make it as fair for everyone as possible. Our goal is to be as inclusive as possible. Over the years we have tweaked the skins games formats and have always been open to any suggestions that would benefit the greater good. Please feel free to make suggestions and I promise we will consider them.

#### When do we decide to play Lift, Clean and Place?

We always want to play golf as often as we can, the way it was designed; play it where it lies. That is not always possible because of course conditions for various reasons. Going into winter, the course is going to soften up and you will find that we will tend to play more Lift, Clean and Place. Sometimes during the hotter months, we might find the fairways become more unplayable based on dryer conditions and we will do the same. Unfortunately, it's not always as clear cut, but we do our best to ensure that playing in the skins game is fun and fair. Read the tee sheet email for notes on how we are playing it that day.

### Why do results sometimes change from the day of the game until the following day?

Once we enter the scores into Golf Genius, we often get golfers that will send a note to us regarding an incorrect score, either because it was written down wrong or was read to us wrong. Because of this, we must adjust and that affects the scoring and the winnings at times. This is like what we do with tournaments, when we do an audit of the winning scores to ensure all is correct.

### Should I circle my birdies or make marks for bogeys?

- We would appreciate it the person keeping score makes NO marks on the card that will make it more difficult to read. The computer will take care of bogeys and birdies, so there is no need to bring them to our attention. It is much more difficult to add scores and do audits when scorecards are sloppy or have other marks where scores should be. Please use a separate card if you want to track your score using circles, numbers, or squares within the square for scoring.

### Why are we so concerned with speed of play?

I know several members get irritated when speed of play is mentioned. I usually get a response about how "the group got a hole or two behind, but we caught up after that". I always appreciate that but understand with a large group like we have in our skins games, a 10-minute delay early can create a 45-minute delay 7 or 8 groups behind you. Unfortunately, it doesn't work that way. Like a slinky, it will never allow the groups behind you to get back into position. The easiest way to know if you are in position is this: If the group in front of you is walking away from your landing area when you approach your shot, or even if you occasionally have to wait a minute, then you are in position.

On a final note, it's important that you add the first and last name to your scorecards, as well as writing very legible. Remember, others need to read the card, not just you. Also, on the closest markers, I have seen people writing down their first name, or their last name only. Even if you have a unique name, our rules state you **MUST** write your first and last name legibly or you can be disqualified. It's in our rules and will be enforced moving forward because it's getting more difficult for us to spend time trying to figure out who or what the names and numbers are at times.

### **Zelle Instructions**

We continue to offer Zelle to pay for the monthly tournament in advance.

Please remember:

- Zelle payments may only be used for the tournament entry fee of \$85.00. Do not include 50/50 raffle tickets, multiple tournament entries, or membership dues
  - You may submit payment only after you have signed up in Golf Genius. Paying with Zelle does not sign you up!



- No Zelle payments will be accepted after signups close on the Tuesday before the Tournament at 2 PM.
- If you pay after signups close, your payment will be refunded on the following Monday, and you will need to pay by cash or check at the check-in table.
- You must still check in on the morning of the tournament. We need to know you are there, and you need your scorecard and rules.
- No Zelle payments will be accepted at the tournament check-in table.
- Payments may only be made to payment@elpradomensclub.com. You can also select Send Money and use the QR code below.
- Please include your first and last name and "Tournament" in the notes field.
- If you're paying on behalf of another golfer, please send a separate Zelle



payment with their first and last name.
