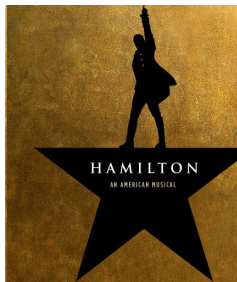


Hamilton at the Forrest Theatre

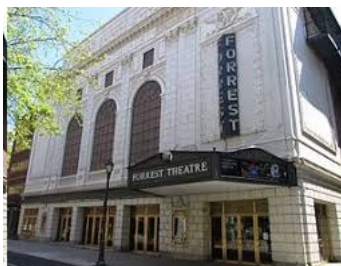
Hamilton is the story of the unlikely Founding Father who was determined to make his mark on a brand new nation as hungry and ambitious as he was. From illegitimate orphan to Washington's right-hand man, from rebel to war hero, from a loving husband caught in the country's first sex scandal, to the Treasury head who made an untrusting world believe in the American economy, Alexander Hamilton embodied the new American spirit. George Washington, Eliza Hamilton, Thomas Jefferson and Hamilton's lifelong friend/foil Aaron Burr all make their mark in this astonishing musical exploration of a political mastermind.

The Forrest Theatre at 1114 Walnut Street is a "road house", used primarily by touring theater and dance companies. Built in 1927, the theater was named in honor of Edwin Forrest, the great Philadelphia born tragic actor of the nineteenth century. It is one of architect Herbert J. Krapp's final theater designs and also one of his more elaborate, built at a cost of over \$2,000,000. The interior was sumptuously decorated with gilt detailing and silk brocade. The dressing rooms are housed in a separate building and connected by an underground tunnel to the Forrest's stage.
