The Church Council held their October meeting via Zoom. Highlights include:

- A report from our piano tuner that it would not be cost effective to repair the current piano and a request for Emily, Tom, and Pastor to explore the purchase of a new piano.
- Approval of bids for the new backflow, paving of the parking lot, and new fencing along the parking lot and Hokuwelowelo to be paid from the proceeds of the mortgage refinancing which were received in mid-October
- Tabled bids for replacement/repair of the office flooring, walls, and blinds
- Voted to approve Tom Poole's letter of transfer from Calvary-by-the-Sea Lutheran
- Joyfully approved the return of singing to our in-person services
- Increased the monthly donation amount from the Kidney Foundation

The 2022 budget will be presented at this meeting but will not be adopted until the January meeting. That will give everyone a chance to look it over and ask questions beforehand as well as at the January meeting.

Please plan to attend this very important meeting on November 28 either in person or via Zoom. We are all together in this ministry called Christ Lutheran Church and we need everyone's participation as we continue to spread the Gospel both within the congregation and without, to those near and far.
