(a) General requirements (2)(i)

The 2nd enclosure on the bottom outdoor portion of the white sheltered facility had a broken piece of wire coated flooring with a sharp point. A white adult female ID # 495-45C-5B79 had a fresh injury to her foot that was bleeding. Broken wire and sharp points can cause injury to the animals. The licensee shall repair or replace the flooring and ensure that there are no sharp points or edges on the surface of the primary enclosures that could harm the animals. TO BE CORRECTED BY 12/17/13

PRIMARY ENCLOSURES.

(a) General requirements (2)(i)

The 2nd enclosure and the 3rd enclosure on the bottom of the outdoor portion of the white sheltered facility had sections of wire coated flooring that was broken. There were sharp wires protruding in the dog area and sections of flooring with wire missing. Broken wire and sharp points can cause injury to the animals. The licensee shall repair or replace the flooring and ensure that there are no sharp points or edges on the surface of the primary enclosures that could harm the animals.

This inspection and exit briefing were conducted with the licensee.

In Mid-December, the inspector found sharp points causing injury to a breeding female.

The inspector said it must be corrected by the next day.

Nearly 5 months later, the problem still existed, and the "breeder" was NOT punished.

Does this sound like a good breeder to you??

Would you let YOUR dog walk around on sharp points?

The USDA inspectors follow shamefully outdated guidelines.

USDA breeders are NOT quality breeders. ESPECIALLY if they have violations.

#### ATTENDING VETERINARIAN AND ADEQUATE VETERINARY CARE (DEALERS AND EXHIBITORS).

There were at least two adult dogs at the facility in need of grooming. A white female ID # 483-F314E54 had facial mats and hair completely covering her eyes. Another white female ID# 482-87F291E had fecal material matted across her buttocks. The dog was removed from its enclosure for further evaluation at which time the licensee removed wads of material from the animals buttocks with scissors. Unkempt hair coats can be irritating and sometimes painful. Matting in these area's may inhibit the animals ability to see, or to defecate comfortably. The licensee shall provide adequate veterinary care which includes regular grooming. Grooming should be done proactively to prevent mats from forming.

TO BE CORRECTED BY : 1/31/2014

This inspection and exit briefing was conducted with the licensee.

A Heartland Pets breeder allowed her dogs to live with mats so bad that the dogs couldn't see or defecate.
