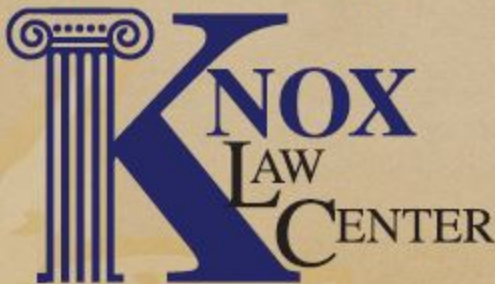

Starfish Story

Diagnosed at birth with cystic fibrosis, Jessica quickly understood the toll that this disease would take upon her body. Despite her own daily struggles, she revelled in helping others. Her spirit is evidenced by her frequent references to this favorite short story:

A young girl was walking along a beach upon which thousands of starfish had washed up during a terrible storm. As she came to each starfish, she would gently pick it up and throw it back into the ocean. People watched her with amusement.

She had been doing this for some time when a man approached her and said, "Little girl, why are you doing this? Look at this beach! You can't save all these starfish. You can't begin to make a difference!"

The girl seemed momentarily crushed, suddenly deflated. But after a few moments, she bent down, picked up another starfish, and tossed it into the ocean. Then she looked up at the man and replied,

The old man looked at the girl inquisitively and thought for a long moment about what she had done and said.

Founder & Inspiration

In her final years, Jessica Link spent more and more time hospitalized at UNC Memorial Hospital dealing with cystic fibrosis-related exacerbations. Through long conversations with her dedicated and caring doctors, nurses and respiratory therapists, Jessica became acutely aware of the financial and emotional challenges facing many adult cystic fibrosis patients. Ever inquisitive, she developed a keen interest in the needs of these often neglected patients as she heard their stories.

It moved her to develop the concept for the Spiritus Project in an effort to ease the financial and emotional stresses experienced by many of these patients as they transitioned from pediatric care to adult care. Although Jessica was unable to launch the Spiritus Project before her passing, family and friends made it their mission to do so to honor Jessica.
