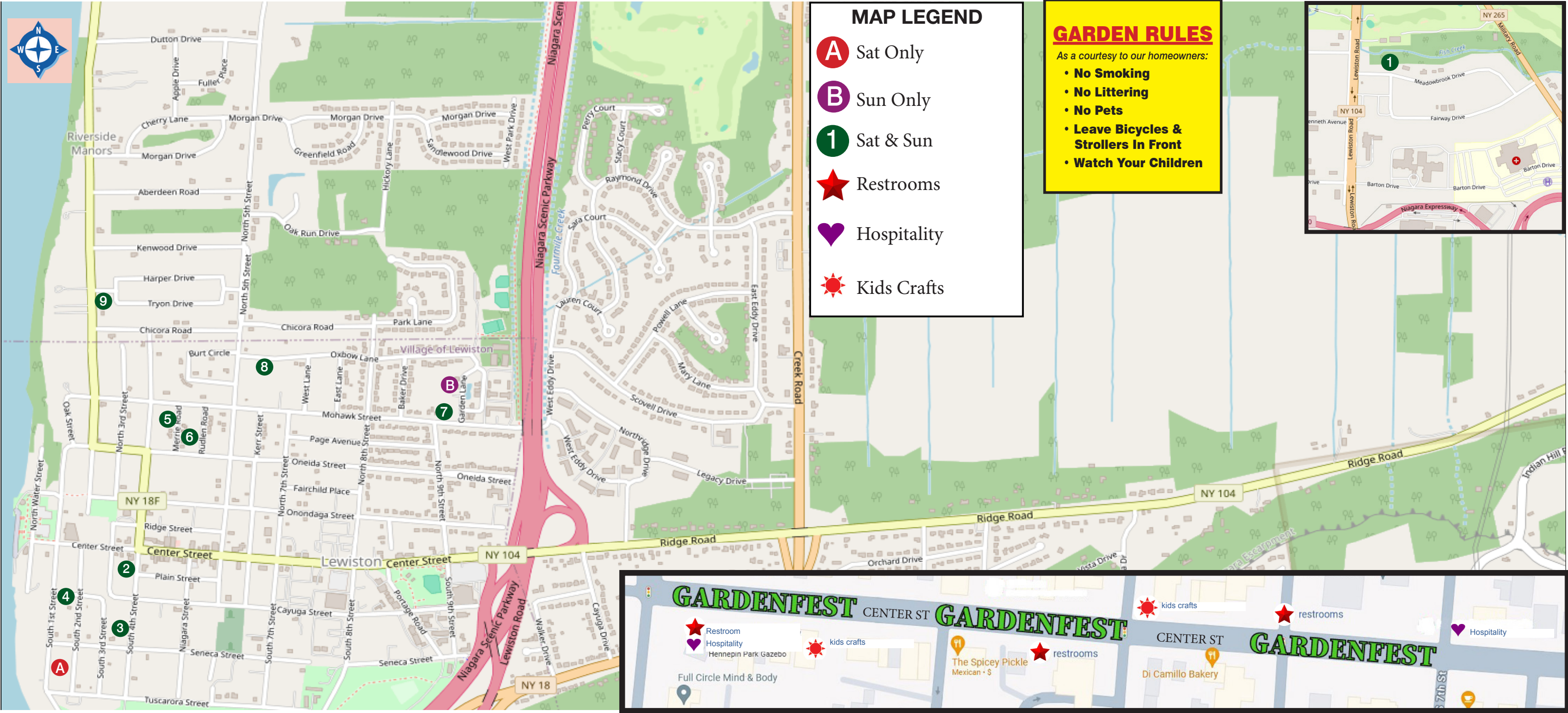




SATURDAY ONLY

Discover a charming pollinator-friendly cottage garden featuring, a classic rose garden, and a delightful berry patch—each element thoughtfully designed to support nature and delight the senses. *(Saturday only)*

B Gary and Nancy Tebo, 407 Garden Lane, entire yard
Welcome to Pondsides Home in the Gardens of Oxbow. The front features a spacious porch, surrounded by Mugho pines, a Ginkgo tree, and a Kisa dogwood. The side garden is adorned with hostas and lilies, while the backyard showcases a charming garden railroad with a small pond. An elevated area includes a 200-foot G-scale track, complete with a pond and mountain tunnel. Three separate tracks wind through the garden, with the mainline stretching across the full width of the property. Buildings are scattered throughout the garden rail and road network, with trains running throughout the day. A magical fairy garden adds a whimsical touch to this enchanting space. *(Sunday only)*

- 1 Lysa Cherrier-Zhang, 505 Meadowbrook Dr., front and side**
Welcome to Meadowbrook Gardens! Take in the beauty of the front hydrangea beds and explore the side yard, blooming with a vibrant array of perennial flowers.
- 2 Ross and Mary Alice Eckert, 175 S. Fourth St., entire yard**
A collection of stunning gardens come together to create a breathtaking full-yard display. Enjoy the Entrance Garden, Fountain Garden, Metal Art Garden, Bird Lovers' Garden, the Sonora Garden featuring a one-of-a-kind eagle sculpture, the serene Koi Pond Garden, and the elegant Peacock Statuary Garden.
- 3 Betty and Tony Girasole, 265 S. Fourth St., entire yard**
Take a leisurely stroll through this joyfully crafted garden retreat nestled along a wooded hillside. Created with a deep love of nature, the property features a ring of beautiful gardens connected by a charming pea gravel path affectionately known as "Hosta Alley".

- 4 Miller Home, 240 S. First St., entire yard**
Begin your tour in the aptly named 'Splash Garden,' inspired by a mid-century in-ground swimming pool. From there, follow the vibrant perennial gardens that line the side yard, guiding you toward the backyard 'Moon Gardens'—a serene space designed with colors, shapes, and textures that come to life both in daylight and under soft, low-light evening skies.
- 5 Miklitsch Merrie Gardens, 315 Merrie Rd, entire yard**
Colorful potted plants and blooming bushes line the perimeter, adding vibrant charm throughout. With easy access, ample sunlight, and welcoming pockets of shade, the lush lawn offers a perfect, inviting space for all to enjoy.
- 6 Nicole and Sean Johnson, 310 Merrie rd, entire yard**
These bird- and pollinator-friendly cottage-style gardens are cultivated using chemical-free methods, promoting a healthy and sustainable environment. Features include a peaceful fish pond, a charming birdhouse tree, a mosaic mural honoring Mother Earth, and elements of urban homesteading. This garden is proudly certified as a Wildlife Habitat by the National Garden Clubs.

- 7 Frederick C. Swain, 908 Mohawk St.**
Welcome to my garden—a cheerful space to work, relax, and soak in the beauty of blooming flowers and lush plants. Perennials line the garden's border, highlighted by a graceful tree and foundation shrubs that frame and nestle the front porch.
- 8 Katie Beaver and Richard Maack, 525 Oxbow Lane, entire yard**
This stunning perennial garden also serves as a certified Monarch Waystation, supporting pollinators throughout the seasons. The garden wraps around the yard in graceful layers, with a small open area showcasing a tapestry lawn. Ongoing efforts to incorporate more native plants reflect a commitment to encouraging biodiversity and supporting the local ecosystem.
- 9 Ruth Davis, 4777 Lower River Rd., entire yard**
Explore the extensive gardens featuring mature fruit trees and a lush green wall, thoughtfully designed to be bird- and pollinator-friendly. The space is created with a soft color palette of perennials, annuals, and shrubs, offering a serene setting filled with beautiful, fragrant flowers.
