Regular Meeting

Meeting called to order by Supervisor Chandler at 6:30 p.m. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Roll call: Goodin, Chandler, Wiederhold, Missler and Curley were present.

Motion by Goodin to approve the agenda as written. Support by Missler. Motion carried.

Motion by Wiederhold to approve the June 15<sup>th</sup> 2020 regular meeting minutes. Support by Missler. Motion carried.

Treasurer Report: Wiederhold

Received \$2,340.67 from D&P Cable for franchise fees. Received \$41,544 from the State of Michigan for constitutional sales tax. Opened a new CD for fire truck fund in the amount of \$75,944.17. Received \$18,000 from the City of Petersburg for fire department contract. Total amount in all accounts is \$2,522,880.74. Motion by Curley to accept Treasurer's report. Support by Goodin. Motion carried.

Clerk Goodin presented checks. I'm holding check #32205 made payable to Stevens Disposal in the amount of \$2,000 until I can check on mutual agreement regarding clean-up day. Motion by Wiederhold to approve checks #32179-#32316 in the amount of \$35,288.73. Support by Curley. Roll call vote: 5 yeas, 0 nays. Motion carried.

Public Comment – Troy Goodnough introduced himself. He is running for Monroe County Sheriff. Ms. Shafer shared her concerns about the KOA located in Summerfield Township.

New Business:

Service Agreement for Monroe County Conservation District – Motion by Goodin to approve the service agreement between Summerfield Township and the Monroe Conservation District. We agree to pay \$750 for the fiscal year 2020-2021 for their services. Support by Missler. Roll call vote: 5 yeas, 0 nays. Motion carried.

Air Conditioner Repair for Fire Department - Received two bids for removing and replacing evaporator for the air conditioning system. Miller's Nu-Tech estimate was \$1,850 and Thompson's was \$1,300. Supervisor Chandler spoke to a professional in the field and he felt both were fair prices. Motion by Wiederhold to hire Thompson's Plumbing & Heating to make the repair. Support by Curley. Roll call vote: 5 yeas, 0 nays. Motion carried.

Land Division – Cremer – Motion by Goodin and supported by Missler to approve land split for Cremer property located at 18485 Todd Road (parcel #14-128-003-01). Roll call vote: 5 yeas, 0 nays. Motion carried.

Supervisor: Chandler

Received a letter in regards to N. County Line Road between Keegan Street & River Road. The gentleman would love to see the road paved. The issue is drainage.

Trustee: Missler

Inquired about seeding after a burial in Pleasant View Cemetery. Clerk Goodin stated that the Sexton will plant the seed after closing a burial, but we do not water it or replant it. The owner of the lot has the right to plant grass.
