Almost forty years ago, a group of concerned citizens banded together to increase awareness and preserve the historic buildings and culture of Stockyards City. Realizing that a number of historic buildings in surrounding communities, including Oklahoma City, were being demolished, these visionaries sought to maintain the original western and agricultural flavor of the area and promote the economic vitality of the livestock, retail and commercial industries in Stockyards City.

Stockyards City Main Street continues to carry on the legacy of the original leaders by representing more than 60 local businesses, two separate shelters, a fire station, one of the oldest continuously operating libraries in Oklahoma City, an F.O.P lodge, a music school and a young residential community with an elementary school within a half mile of the district's east end.



Visitors from around the world seek out the nostalgia and undying ethic of the working cowboy and as the home to the world's largest active stockyards, the Oklahoma National Stockyards, the oldest continuously operating restaurant in Oklahoma City and the first industrial section in the Oklahoma City metro area initiating the future rapid growth of the agricultural industry, still today paints an authentic picture of the great American West. Not only is Stockyards City the first urban Main Street in Oklahoma, it also holds a prominent place in the National Register of Historic Places.


