

# **ELSIE O'LEARY**

**1899 - 1988**

Elsie J. (Nadeau) O'Leary, 89 of Caseville, passed away Wednesday, April 20 at St. Luke's Hospital, Saginaw, after a long illness.

She was born Feb. 8, 1899 in Fremont, Ohio, daughter of the late James and Evangeline (Campbell) Gleason.

She married Charles E. Nadeau on Feb. 1, 1920 in Detroit. He preceded her in death on Dec. 27, 1962. She later married James O'Leary on June 8, 1973 in Detroit.

Mrs. O'Leary moved to Detroit as a young girl and lived there most of her life, except for a short time in Muskegon. She moved to Caseville about two years ago.

She was a member of St. Roch's Catholic Church, Caseville, a past member of St. Charles Catholic Church and its altar society, Detroit, and a past member of the Marine Corps Auxiliary.

Funeral services were conducted Saturday, April 23 at St. Roch Catholic Church. The Rev. Fr. Theodore LaMarre, pastor, officiated with burial in the church cemetery.
